Botswana Food Imports July 2023


Dotswana's total imports were valued at P6, 897,364, 155.2 in July 2023. The share of food during this period was P1, 063,990,477.2 equivalent to 15.4 percent of total imports. Beverages, Spirits & Vinegar accounted for most imported food items at 18.6 percent. Cereals and Preparations of cereals, flour, starch or milk; pastry cooks' products followed with 18.4 percent and 8.9 percent respectively.

In July 2023, among the Beverages, Spirits and Vinegar chapter, the most imported commodities were Beer made from malt and other fermented beverages (cider, perry, mead, sake) & non-alcoholic beverages with contributions of 24.0 percent and 20.8 percent respectively. Mineral and aerated waters containing added sugar or other sweetening matter or flavored accounted for 17.7 percent.

Regarding the Cereals chapter; Other Wheat & muslin and Maize (corn) excluding Seeds accounted for 43.2 percent and 29.9 percent in that order to the cereal chapter. Semi or wholly milled rice whether or not polished or glazed contributed 17.7 percent.
