

BOTSWANA FOOD IMPORTS

June 2022

Botswana's total imports were valued at **P8,419,377,021** during the month of June 2022. In this amount, Food imports contributed **P2, 250,519,725**, translating to 26.7 percent. Sugars & Sugar Confectionery accounted for 48.6 percent of food imports. Cereals and Beverages, Spirits & Vinegar followed with 19.4 percent and 6.6 percent respectively.


Among Sugars & Sugar Confectionery the most imported types were Sucrose, chemically pure, in solid form, not containing added flavouring or colouring matter, accounting for 74.1 percent. Beet sugar, raw, in solid form, not containing added flavouring or colouring matter followed with a contributions of 18.1 percent.

Regarding Cereals, the most imported commodity in June 2022, was Wheat and muslin, other than durum wheat, other than seed and Maize (corn), other than seed accounting for 78.1 percent and 14.9 percent respectively.
