

# Transport and Infrastructure Stats Brief Quarter 3, 2021

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**STATISTICS BOTSWANA**

## 1. Introduction

This Stats Brief presents a summary of the latest Transport and Infrastructure Statistics for Quarter 3, 2021. It covers Motor Vehicle Registrations, Rail, Water and Air Transport statistics.

Vehicles registered for the first time this quarter were 10,494, which was an increase of 0.9 percent from Q2 2021. Out of this total 79.6 percent were used, while 20.3 and 0.1 percent were brand new and rebuilt vehicles respectively.

The volume of goods transported through rail this quarter was 279,868 net tonnes, a 2.5 percent increase when compared to Q2 2021. Total revenue of P53,890,000 was generated from the transportation of these goods.

During this quarter, 36,786 passengers used the pontoon and 92.0 percent of the passengers were non – citizens. Citizens made up 8.0 percent of the total pontoon passengers.

A total of 12,177 aircraft movements were recorded this quarter and 22.8 percent of these were international whilst 77.2 percent were domestic. Air passenger movements increased by 28.8 percent when compared to the passenger movements recorded in the previous quarter.

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

## 2. Motor Vehicle Registration

### 2.1 Motor Vehicle First Registrations

A total of 10,494 first registrations were recorded this quarter, which was an increase of 0.9 percent when compared to 10,398 registered in the previous quarter. Passenger cars made up 69.8 percent followed by vans with 9.0 percent of the total first registrations. See **Figure 1** and **Table 1** in **Appendix 1**

Most of the vehicles which were registered for the first time this quarter were from Japan, accounting for 69.1 percent of which 99.5 percent were used. Vehicles from South Africa constituted 19.1 percent of the total and 79.8 percent of these vehicles were brand new. See **Table 2** in **Appendix 1**

During this quarter, Toyota recorded the highest number of first registrations constituting 31.0 percent of the total, but this was a decline of 6.0 percent when compared to the total Toyotas registered in the previous quarter. Mazda registered the second highest number with 12.1 percent which was a decline of 9.1 percent when compared to the previous quarter. See **Table 3** in **Appendix 1**

The majority of the first registrations were recorded during the month of August with 35.3 in this quarter whilst the months of September and July constituted 32.7 percent and 32.0 percent of the total first registrations respectively. See **Table 4** in **Appendix 1**

### 2.2 Motor Vehicle Renewals

Vehicle licenses renewals recorded this quarter increased by 16.1 percent to 151,079 compared to the 130,168 renewals registered in the previous quarter. Passenger cars accounted for 64.4 percent, followed by vans with 18.7 percent. See **Table 5** in **Appendix 1**

Vehicle license renewals recorded in August constituted 34.3 percent, which was the highest for this quarter. The months of July and September registered 32.6 percent and 33.1 percent of this quarter's total respectively. See **Table 6** in **Appendix 1**.

Toyota make license renewals constituted 45.4 percent of the total at 68,652, of which 64.9 percent of these were passenger cars. Tractors of the make of Massey Ferguson constituted 53.5 percent of the total renewals of tractors. See **Table 7** in **Appendix 1**


### 3. Rail Transport

#### 3.1 Goods Traffic

A total of 279,868 net tonnes of goods were transported through rail in Q3 2021. This was an increase of 2.5 percent from 273,058 net tonnes transported in the previous quarter. Most of the goods were transported during the month of August, constituting 34.9 percent of the total whilst the months of July and September constituted 33.5 percent and 31.7 percent respectively. **Figure 2** shows that the number of goods transported through rail has declined from year to year over the past 5 years.

#### 3.2 Revenue

Revenue generated from the transportation of rail goods totaled P53,890.00, an increase of 0.9 percent compared to the revenue generated of P53,392.00 in the previous quarter. Revenue generated from Botswana Total constituted 88.8 percent of total revenue, Total Exports accounted for 49.6 percent while Total Imports generated 19.7 percent. The highest revenue was generated during the month of July at 36.9 percent. See [Table 9 in Appendix 2](#)


### 4. Water Transport

#### 4.1 Pontoon Passengers

During Q3 2021, a total of 36,786 passengers used the pontoon and 49.4 percent of these passengers were arriving into the country whereas 50.6 percent departed from the country. Total pontoon passengers increased by 7.7 percent when compared to 34,164 passengers from the previous quarter. Non-citizens made up 92.5 percent of the arrivals and 91.5 percent of the departures, whilst citizens accounted for 7.5 percent and 8.5 percent of the arrivals and departures respectively.

Compared to the previous quarter arrivals and departures increased by 3.4 and 12.2 percent respectively. See [Table 10 in Appendix 3](#)

**Figure 3** above shows the performance of pontoon passenger movements from January to September 2021; total passengers movements have increased at a fluctuating rate, the same as for total arrivals and total departures.


## 5. Air Transport

### 5.1 Aircraft Movements

During Q3 2021, a total of 12,177 aircraft movements were recorded. This was a 34.1 percent increase from the 9,081 aircraft movements recorded in Q2 2021. Domestic aircraft movements constituted 77.2 percent of the total, while International movements made up 22.8 percent. See **Table 11** in **Appendix 4**

Non-scheduled departures accounted for 38.5 percent of total aircraft movements while 38.4 percent of the movements were non – scheduled arrivals. Both scheduled arrivals and departures accounted for 8.6 percent of the total, Scenic flights accounted for 5.1 percent of total domestic aircraft movements. Most of the aircraft movements in Q3 2021 were recorded during the month of August, at 35.2 percent and 64.8 percent of these were recorded at Maun Airport. Months of July and September recorded 32.0 percent and 32.8 percent of the total aircraft movements respectively. Maun was the busiest airport with 65.3 percent of total aircraft movements, followed by Sir Seretse Khama International airport with 17.6 percent. See [Table 13](#) in [Appendix 4](#).

## 5.2 Air Passenger Movements

A total of 89,708 passenger movements were recorded in Q3 2021, an increase of 28.8 percent compared to the previous quarter. Domestic passenger movement accounted for 51.8 percent while international passenger movement made up 48.2 percent. Compared to Q2 2021, international passenger movements increased by 30.2 percent while domestic movements decreased by 27.5 percent. See [Table 14](#) in [Appendix 4](#)

Most of the passenger movements recorded this quarter were scheduled which accounted for 69.3 percent of the total. Non - scheduled movements constituted 28.4 percent while private and scenic movements constituted 0.5 and 1.8 percent respectively. Scenic passenger movements increased by more than 100 percent while non-scheduled and scheduled movements increased by 68.3 and 16.8 percent, respectively. Meanwhile private passenger movements went down by 24.3 percent.

Maun airport recorded most of the passenger movements with 42.5 percent and 49.4 percent of these movements were non – scheduled. Sir Seretse Khama International Airport (SSKIA) was second with 40.8 percent and 94.4 percent of these movements were scheduled. All the scenic passenger movements were registered at Maun airport.
