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# TRANSPORT & INFRASTRUCTURE STATS BRIEF QUARTER 2 2021

### **Preface**

This Stats Brief presents a summary of the latest Transport and Infrastructure Statistics for Quarter 2, 2021. It has Air, Rail and Water Transport as well as Motor Vehicle Registrations statistics.

A total of 10,398 vehicles were registered for the first time in Q2 2021. Out of these vehicles 81.6 percent were used vehicles, Brand new and rebuilt vehicles registered 18.2 and 0.2 percent of the total respectively.

Total passenger movements went up by 49.8 percent when compared to the previous quarter. International and domestic air passenger movements increased by 57.7 percent and 43.3 percent respectively when compared to the previous quarter.

A total of 273,058 net tonnes of goods were carried through rail and revenue of P53, 392,000 was generated from the transportation of the goods. Volume of goods transported through rail increased by 1.2 percent while revenue went down by 3.4 percent when compared to Quarter 1.

## 2. Motor Vehicle Registration

# 2.1 Motor Vehicle First Registrations

A total of 10,398 motor vehicles were registered for the first time during this quarter, Q2 2021. This represents a decrease of 18.4 percent when compared to the previous quarter. Passenger cars registered 72.9% of total first registrations followed by vans with 8.6%. See **Table 1** in **Appendix 1**




Figure 1: First Registrations by Type of Vehicle (Percentage)

From the total first registrations 81.6 percent were used vehicles, Brand new and rebuilt vehicles registered 18.2 and 0.2 percent of the total. Most of the firstly registered vehicles were from Japan at 71.7 percent of the total. Out of the vehicles from Japan 99.5 percent were used vehicles. South Africa came second after Japan at 17.3 percent of the total. See **figure 1** and **Table 2** in **Appendix 1**.

Toyota was the most popular motor vehicle make, registering 33.3 percent of total first registrations. Mazda recorded the second highest number of first registrations with 13.5 percent. All the homemade vehicles were Trailers registering 45.7% of total registered trailers. See **Table 3** in **Appendix 1** 

The month of April, constituted 36.8 percent of the total first registrations. The months of May and June made up 29.4 and 33.9 percent respectively. See **Table 4** in **Appendix 1** 

### 2.2 Motor Vehicle License Renewals

A total of 130,168 vehicle licenses were renewed in Q2 2021, an increase of 5.3 percent compared to the previous quarter. Vehicle licenses renewed in the month of June constituted 35.4 percent of total renewed licenses. Months of May and April recorded 32.7 and 31.9 percent of the total respectively. See **Table 5** and **6** in **Appendix1**.

Most of the vehicle license renewals were of Toyota which accounted for 46.0 percent of total license renewals, of which 64.1 percent were passenger cars. Toyota license renewals were followed by Mazda with 7.6 percent. Honda license renewals and Nissan accounted for 7.3 and 6.9 percent of total renewals respectively. See **Tables 7** in **Appendix 1**.

### 3. Air Transport

### 3.1 Aircraft Movements

A total of 9,081 aircraft movements were recorded in Q2 2021; an increase of over 100 percent compared to the 4,463 aircraft movements recorded in the previous quarter. International aircraft movements made up 25.3 percent of these movements while 74.7 percent were domestic. See **Table 8** in **Appendix 2**.

Non-scheduled departures made up 36.2 of the total aircraft movements registered this quarter and 86.6 percent of these were domestic. International scheduled arrivals and departures constituted 27.8 percent each of the total international aircraft movements. This is shown in **Table 9** in **Appendix 2**.

During the quarter under review, the majority of the aircraft movements were recorded at Maun airport with 60.4 percent and 38.2 percent of these recorded during the month of June. There was an increase in the number of aircraft movements recorded this quarter at all the airports when compared to the previous quarter except for Ghanzi which realised a decrease of 30.8 percent. Details are shown in **Table 10** in **Appendix 2**.





Figure 2: Quarter-to-Quarter percentage change (Aircraft Movements), Q1 2018 to Q2 2021

**Figure 2 below** shows the trend of aircraft movements from Q1 2018 to Q2 2021; it shows the huge drop in aircraft movements realised in Q2 2020 due to movement restrictions, and when compared to Q2 2021, the aircraft movements went up drastically.

# 3.2 Air Passenger Movements

Passenger movements for this quarter totaled 69,656, an increase of 49.8 percent when compared to Q1 2021. International movements made up 47.6 percent of the passenger movements while 52.4 percent were domestic. In comparison to the previous quarter, international passenger movements increased by 57.7 percent while domestic movements increased by 43.3 percent. See **Table 11** in **Appendix 2** 

Scheduled passenger movements constituted 76.4 percent of the total movements recorded this quarter. This was an increase of 33.6 percent when compared to Q1 2021. Non - scheduled movements accounted for 21.7 percent of the total. Both private and scenic passenger movements constituted 0.9 percent of the total. This is shown in **Table 12** in **Appendix 2** and **Figure 3** below.

Sir Seretse Khama International Airport (SSKIA) recorded the majority of the total passenger movements with 47.2 percent. Most of the scheduled movements were recorded at SSKIA with 58.9 percent of total scheduled movements. The airport with the second highest number of passenger movements was Maun with 36.3 percent. Maun airport recorded most of the non-scheduled movements at 76.9 percent of the total. See **Table 13** in **Appendix 2**.

### 4. Rail Transport

### 4.1 Goods Traffic

During the quarter under review, a total of 273,058 net tonnes of goods were carried through rail and this was a decrease of 1.2 percent when compared to the previous quarter. The majority of these goods were transported during the month of April at 35.3 percent. Goods transported in June and May accounted for 33.2 and 31.5 percent respectively. Botswana Total and Total Exports made up 83.2 and 36.7 percent of the total net tonnes transported this quarter, respectively. See **Table 14** in **Appendix 3** 

### 4.2 Revenue

A total revenue of P53, 392,000 was generated from the transportation of the goods and 33.8 percent of the revenue was generated during the month of April. Total revenue declined by 3.4 percent when compared to the previous quarter. See Table 15 in **Appendix 3** and **Figure 4**.

# **Explanatory Notes**

### 1. Motor Vehicle Registrations

Motor vehicle registration deals with licensing of motor vehicles with respect to those registered for the first time and license renewal of pre-existing ones. First registrations are done at the Department of Road Transport and Safety (DRTS) only, while renewals are done at DRTS offices, Post Offices country wide and some stores like Sefalana Cash and Carry. First Registration could be new, used or rebuilt.

# 2. Air Transport

Air transport section covers the movement of aircrafts and air passengers both locally and internationally.

International movements refer to movements made by aircrafts and passengers to destinations outside Botswana whilst domestic movements account for travels made within Botswana. The movements are further categorized into scheduled, non-scheduled and private.

Scheduled aircraft movements refer to commercial airlines operating on a time table while non-scheduled aircraft movements refer to commercial aircrafts which operate as and when needed. Private aircraft movements refer to non-commercial individual aircrafts. Scenic aircraft movements refer to airlines that focus on wildlife and surrounding natures.

# 3. Rail Transport

Rail Transport covers passengers and goods transported by rail and the revenue generated from the conveyance of these goods and passengers. Botswana Origin is comprised of Total Exports and Local Traffic goods while Botswana Total is an addition of Total Imports and Botswana Origin goods. Total Traffic is made up of Total Exports, Total Imports, Local Traffic and Transit Traffic. Local traffic is goods transported within Botswana and Transit Traffic is goods transported through Botswana to other countries.
