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## 2007 AND 2008 ANNUAL AGRICULTURAL SURVEY PRELIMINARY RESULTS

### PREFACE

The agriculture sector in Botswana, like in many countries, plays an important role in providing food, income, employment and investment opportunities for majority of people, particularly the rural community. The sector's contribution to the Gross Domestic Product (GDP) has been decreasing over years to less than 3 percent in recent years. However, the livestock sub sector contribution to the economy through foreign earnings has been significant; that is, between 2007 and 2008, beef, hides and skin exports accounted for 2.2 and 2.0 percent of the country's exports respectively (CSO, External Trade annual Report 2007-8).

It is hoped that the continued Government interventions, including the recent ISPAAD program, which are aimed at improving the performance of the sector, particularly the arable sub sector, will, however, reduce the dependence on cereal exports as the country is still a net importer of cereals.

This Stats Brief highlights preliminary results of the main agricultural sector indicators from the 2007 and 2008 Annual Agricultural surveys. It should also be noted that these results are provisional pending the ongoing editing processes until the production of the final report expected to be published in October 2011.

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## **1.0 ANALYSIS OF THE PRELIMINARY RESULTS**

### **1.1 Agricultural Holders (Farmers)**

This Stats Brief highlights the 2007 and 2008 Annual Agricultural Surveys preliminary results. It is worth noting that the discussions will be based mostly on the traditional sector because of its dominance of the agricultural sector.

The results indicate that between 2007 and 2008 agricultural seasons, the number of farmers participating in agricultural activities has made a significant difference particularly under the traditional sector; that is, the number of farmers rose from 111,384 in 2007 to 130,852 in 2008, representing a 17.6 percent increase at national level (**Tables 1 and 3**).

The dominance of the male agricultural farmers under the traditional sector is observed and it constituted 58.6 and 59.1 percent respectively between 2007 and 2008 as compared to their female counterparts (**Table 3**).

The results of the survey also suggest that the dependence on purchased food as opposed to ‘own farm produce’ is higher among the farming community contributing 90.1 percent in 2007 and 94.5 percent in 2008 (**Table 4**).

While agricultural activities are labour intensive, the results suggest a low proportion of engagement of farm workers under the traditional sector, which accounted for 17.0 and 15.6 percent in 2007 and 2008 respectively (**Table 5**).

### **1.2 Livestock Statistics**

Livestock statistics comprise of cattle, goats, sheep, donkeys/mules, horses, pigs, ostriches, chicken and others but this summary will only concentrates on the three major ones, namely, cattle, goats and sheep.

The 2007 and 2008 annual agricultural survey results indicate that the majority of livestock ownership is skewed to male headed communities as compared to their female counterparts for different types of livestock under the traditional sector (69.4, 62.6 and 72.0 percent) for cattle, goats and sheep in that order in 2007 (**Table 1**). The

same pattern was observed in 2008 (69.3, 61.0 and 70.3 percent for cattle, goats and sheep in that order).

### 1.2.1 Cattle

There has been a significant increase of 16.4 percent in cattle holdings between 2007 and 2008 agricultural seasons. The number of cattle holders rose from 66,472 in 2007 to 77,342 in 2008 at national level. The cattle population significantly increased by 23.7 percent from 1.797 million in 2007 to 2.222 million in 2008. In all the years, the traditional sector dominated the cattle industry constituting over 90.0 percent of the cattle population (**Tables 1 and 6**).

**Figure 1.2.1: Cattle Population Trend from 1997 to 2008**




Figure 1.2.1 shows cattle population trend from 1997 to 2008. The trend depicts a constant pattern ranging between 2.0 and 2.5 million except in 2002, where the population rose to about 3.0 million, and was the lowest in 2007 at about 1.8 million.

There have been significant differences in cattle mortality rates between 2007 and 2008 agricultural seasons. Cattle mortality rates were 9.5 percent in 2006, went down to 8.1 percent in 2007 to 5.8 percent in 2008 at national level (**Tables 1, 7 and 8**).

Comparisons of cattle off-take rates<sup>1</sup> between the 2007 and 2008 agricultural seasons show significant variations of 9.4 percent in 2007 and 8.1 in 2008 at national level. The commercial sector showed a high but constant offtake rate of 19.2 percent during the same period (**Tables 1, 7and 8**).

There has been a significant difference in cattle birth rate between 2007 and 2008 agricultural seasons as cattle birth rate went down to 46.7 percent in 2008 from 59.1 percent in 2007 at national level (**Tables 1, 7and 8**). A graphical presentation of cattle production indicators trends from 1997 to 2008 for the traditional sector is given as Figure 1.2.1

Figure 1.2.1: **Traditional Sector:** Cattle Production Indicators Trends from 1997 to 2008.




Figure 1.2.1 shows that cattle birth rates were constantly between 50 and 60 percent except in 2003 and 2008 while off take and mortality rates had barely gone beyond 10 percent except in 2003.

## 1.2.2 Goats

Farmers rearing goats have slightly increased between 2007 and 2008 agricultural seasons; from 77,400 in 2007 to 91,179 in 2008, a 17.8 percent increase at national level. Similarly goats' population significantly increased by 14.5 percent; from 1.642

million to 1.880 million during the same period. In all these seasons the traditional sector dominated (**Tables 1 and 10**).

**Figure 1.2.2: Goats Population (000) Trend from 1997 to 2008**




Figure 1.2.2 shows goats' population trend from 1997 to 2008. The figure depicts a downward trend with some improvements since 2004.

The goats' production indicators (birth, death and off-take rates) were 42.2, 16.3 and 6.6 percent respectively in 2007 as opposed to 44.8, 23.5 and 6.6 percent in 2008 at national level (**Tables 1, 11 and 12**).

**Figure 1.2.2A: Traditional Sector: Goats Production Indicators Trends from 1997 to 2008.**




Figure 1.2.2A shows that goats' birth rates ranged between 40 and 50 percent and were highest in 2004 while off take rates were below 10 percent.

### 1.2.3 Sheep

There has been an increase in the number of farmers rearing sheep between 2007 and 2008 agricultural seasons; from 17,874 to 20,859, a 16.7 percent increase at national level. Sheep population also increased by 19.8 percent; from 252,848 to 302,980 during the period under consideration (**Tables 1 and 14**).

**Figure 1.2.3: Sheep Population (000) Trend from 1997 to 2008**




Figure 1.2.3 shows sheep population trend from 1997 to 2008. The figure indicates a downward trend with improvements from the 2007 agricultural season.

The production indicators (birth, death and off-take rates) were 34.1 percent, 12.6 percent and 6.1 percent respectively in 2007 as compared to 35.0 percent, 13.4 percent and 5.7 percent in 2008 at national level (**Tables 1, 15 and 16**).

**Figure 1.2.3A: Traditional Sector: Trends of Sheep Production Indicators from 1996 to 2006.**




Figure 1.2.3A shows slight differences for all the indicators between 2007 and 2008 agricultural seasons.

### **1.3 Crop Statistics**

This section gives a summary of crop statistics for 2007 and 2008 cropping seasons. Crops discussed include sorghum, maize, millet, beans/pulses, sunflower and groundnuts. However, the discussion will concentrates on major crops such as sorghum, maize, millet and beans/pulses.

The 2007 and 2008 annual agricultural survey results indicate that the number of farmers with crop land significantly increased by 29.2 percent; from 59,823 in 2007 to 77,291 in 2008. Total land area<sup>2</sup> also increased significantly by 55.8 percent; from 183,139 hectares to 285,298 hectares between the two agricultural seasons (**Tables 2 and 20**).

The extent of land utilization between 2007 and 2008 widened as about 40.7 percent of land was not utilized in 2007 as opposed to 20.6 percent in 2008. This might be due to the fact that 2007 was a drought year and had impacted negatively on cropping activities of the same year, while the ISPAAD program, which started in 2008, might have had a positive impact. In all cases the traditional sector dominated.

A total of 41,373 farmers planted some crops covering an area of 108,558 (of which 102,591 hectares were under the traditional sector) hectares in 2007 when compared to 74,465 farmers covering an area of 226,541 hectares (of which 203,734 hectares were under the traditional sector) hectares in 2008. However, a small proportion of farmers of about 26.2 percent in 2007 harvested some crops as opposed to 65.5 percent) in 2008. A highly significant increase in area planted under the commercial sector was also noted as it rose from 5,967 hectares in 2007 to 22,807 hectares in 2008 (**Tables 2, 21 and 22**).

A graphical presentation of crop land holdings, holdings planted and holdings harvested trends from 1997 to 2008 is given as figure 1.3.

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
<sup>2</sup> Land area refers to area planted + fallow land area. Fallow land is land not ploughed during the survey season but was ploughed during the past year(s). For a piece of land to be regarded as fallow it has to stay at most five years without being ploughed. However, this differs from one region to the other. Land area may also increase or decrease depending on the extent of its utilization in a given agricultural season.

Figure 1.3 suggests a downward trend on the number of farmers with land (land holdings), those who planted some crops (holdings planted) and those who harvested some crops (holdings harvested) with some fluctuations observed on holdings planted and harvested. There are however, some improvements on these indicators in 2008.

Figures 1.3A displays the downward and fluctuating trends on land area, area planted and harvested with some improvements observed in 2008 for all the indicators.

### **1.3.1 Sorghum**

The number of farmers who planted sorghum rose from 27,019 in 2007 to 48,038 in 2008, a 77.8 percent increase. Area planted of the same crop also increased by over a fold from 33,291 hectares to 73,159 hectares between the two agricultural seasons. The traditional sector accounted for 90.6 and 86.4 percent of the area planted of the crop under consideration for 2007 and 2008 respectively (**Tables 2, 23 and 24**).

Area harvested significantly increased by over three folds from 10,027 hectares to 42,914 hectares during the same period (**Tables 2, 25 and 26**). Total production under the same crop also increased from 11,774 metric tonnes in 2007 to 23,633 metric tonnes in 2008 while yield per hectare planted went down by 8.7 percent, from 354 kg/ha to 323 kg/ha during the same period at national level. However, significant increases were realised in the total production under the commercial sector, though yield per hectare planted reduced from 3,356 kg/ha in 2007 to 1,855 kg/ha in 2008 (**Tables 2, 27 -30**).




Figure 1.3.1 depicts a decline in sorghum area planted, particularly in 2001 and 2003 with low production in 2001, 2003 and 2007 agricultural seasons.

### 1.3.2 Maize

Farmers who planted maize increased by 87.0 percent, from 37,599 in 2007 to 70,332 in 2008, with highly significant increases of over a fold in area planted, which rose from 40,750 hectares to 88,614 hectares between the two agricultural seasons (**Tables 2, 23 and 24**). Area harvested also increased significantly by over four folds between the two agricultural seasons, from 8,394 hectares to 48,663 hectares with increases in yield per hectare planted from 53 kg/ha to 101 kg/ha (**Tables 2, 25-30**). Significant increase was observed in yield per hectare planted under the commercial sector, as it rose from 773 kg/ha to 3,142 kg/ha.

Of note is the fact that farmers tend to plant more maize as compared to sorghum as it used to be the case in the past years, more specifically under the traditional sector.

A graphical presentation of Area Planted, Area Harvested and Total Production Trends from 1997 to 2008 is given as Figure 4.2

**Figure 1.3.2: Traditional Sector - Maize:** Area Planted, Area Harvested and Total Production from 1997 to 2008




Figure 1.3.2 depicts fluctuations in both maize area planted and harvested as well as production.


### 1.3.3 Millet

Total number of farmers who planted millet increased from 12,762 in 2007 to 19,041 in 2008 with further significant increases in the area planted of 88.8 percent; from 6,010 hectares to 11,348 hectares during the same period. Similarly, total area harvested increased by over two folds; from 2,330 hectares in 2007 to 7,650 hectares in 2008 (**Tables 2, 23 and 24**).

Millet total production also significantly increased by over two folds; from 532 metric tonnes in 2007 to 1,637 metric tonnes in 2008 with further increases realized in the yield per hectare planted; from 89 kg/ha to 144 kg/ha. Increases in the production was realised under the traditional sector as opposed to reductions under the commercial sector though the reverse is true with yield per hectare planted (**Tables 2, 27-30**).

A graphical presentation of area planted, area harvested and Total Production Trends from 1997 to 2008 is given as Figure 1.3.3 for the Traditional sector only.

### 1.3.4 Beans/Pulses

Farmers who planted beans/pulses significantly increased by 87.2 percent; from 35,613 in 2007 to 66,659 in 2008. Similarly area planted under the same crop rose by increased from 18,634 hectares to 29,545 hectares with further significant increases of over two folds in area harvested; from 3,732 hectares to 13,938 hectares during the same period (**Tables 2, 23 - 26**). Total production of beans/pulses also rose from 803 metric tonnes to 2,305 metric tonnes between 2007 and 2008 agricultural seasons, with yields also increasing from 43 kg/ha to 78 kg/ha. Higher yields were realised under the commercial sector between the two periods (**Tables 2, 27 - 30**).

A graphical presentation of Area Planted, Area Harvested and Total Production Trends from 1997 to 2008 is given as Figure 1.3.4 for the traditional sector only.


