



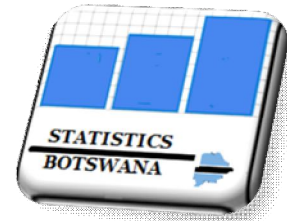

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2009 AND 2010 ANNUAL AGRICULTURAL SURVEYS PRELIMINARY RESULTS

The agriculture sector in Botswana, like in many countries, plays an important role in providing food, income, employment and investment opportunities for majority of people, particularly the rural community. The sector's contribution to the Gross Domestic (GDP) has decreased over the years from an impressive 40 percent at independence (1966) to 2.8 percent in 2009 and further to 2.4 percent in 2010 (Statistics Botswana, National Accounts Statistics – Gross Domestic Product: Fourth Quarter & Annual 2011 Stats Brief).

However, the livestock sub sector contribution to the economy through foreign earnings has been significant; that is, between 2009 and 2010, meat and meat products, hides and skin exports accounted for 3.4 and 3.5 percent of the country's exports respectively (Statistics Botswana, External Trade Statistics 2010), being the third and second highest contributor during these periods.

The recent introduction of ISPAAD programme which is geared at improving agricultural production has made significant increases in the crop production though the country still depends on cereal imports.

This Stats Brief highlights preliminary results of the main agricultural sector indicators from the 2009 and 2010 Annual Agricultural surveys. It should also be noted that these results are provisional pending the ongoing editing processes until the production of the final report expected to be published in October 2012.

1.0 ANALYSIS OF THE PRELIMINARY RESULTS

1.1 Agricultural Holders (Farmers)

This Stats Brief highlights the 2009 and 2010 Annual Agricultural Surveys preliminary results. Unless otherwise stated, the discussions will be based mostly on the traditional sector because of its dominance in the agricultural sector. It is worth noting that the percentages quoted in this brief do not form part of the referenced tables.

The results indicate that between 2009 and 2010 agricultural seasons, the number of farmers participating in agricultural activities has made a significant decrease of 6.5 percent particularly under the traditional sector; from 130,010 in 2009 to 121,605 in 2010 (Table 1).

The male dominance of the agricultural sector continues, as it constitutes over 50 percent of the total agricultural farmers (56.7 and 54.9 percent between 2009 and 2010) respectively as compared to their female counterparts (Table 3).

The average age of a farmer is 59 and 69 years for 2009 and 2010 agricultural seasons respectively irrespective of sex (table not shown). However, the engagement of the youth in farming activities is less pronounced, particularly in the age group 12-19 years and thus improves as age increases (Table 4).

While there are a number of sources of income for farmers, 'income from a paid employment' and 'pensions' are noted as the main sources during the 2009 and 2010 agricultural seasons (Tables 5A and 5B). These were followed by 'remittances' in all the years considered. Furthermore, the dependence on 'purchased food' as opposed to 'own farm produce' still continues among the farming community, contributing 79.2 percent in 2009 and 81.5 percent in 2010. In addition, 'own farm produce' showed a significant decrease of 19.7 percent (Table 6).

Although agricultural activities are labour intensive, the results suggest an improvement in the engagement of farm workers under the traditional sector, which accounts for 20.2 and 20.6 percent in 2009 and 2010 respectively as opposed to 16.9 and 15.6 percent in 2007 and 2008 respectively (Table 7). Its worth noting that the average earning of a farm worker was P548.00 for 2009 and P547 for 2010 and this shows a significant increase from P417 and

P525 in 2007 and 2008 respectively. On contrary, average earnings for the commercial sector are higher than that of the traditional sector (P614 and P560 for 2009 and 2010 respectively).

2.0 Livestock Statistics

Livestock statistics comprise of cattle, goats, sheep, donkeys/mules, horses, pigs, ostriches, chicken and others, but this summary will only concentrate on the three major ones, namely, cattle, goats and sheep. However, selected other livestock holdings and population data are presented in Table 17.

The 2009 and 2010 annual agricultural survey results indicate that majority of livestock ownership and engagement of farmers in pastoral farming for different types of livestock under the traditional sector is skewed towards male headed farmers when compared to their female headed counterparts. This gets more pronounced as they grow older and mostly concentrated in farmers aged 65 years and above (Tables 8, 11 and 14). In 2009, male headed farmers stood at 68.4, 60.3 and 70.0 percent for cattle, goats and sheep respectively. The same pattern was observed in 2010 (65.1, 60.2 and 71.1 percent respectively).

2.1 Cattle Holdings, Population and Production Indicators

Cattle holdings slightly decreased from 77,249 in 2009 to 76,928 in 2010 at national level. On contrary, cattle population increased significantly from 2.413 million in 2009 to 2.659 million in 2010 with the traditional sector dominating the cattle industry (Tables 1 & 8).

Cattle mortality rates were generally lower under the commercial sector when compared to the traditional sector setup. This rate was 5.8 percent in 2008, went down to around 5.5 percent in 2009 and 2010 at national level. Under the traditional sector, mortality slightly increased from 5.8 percent in 2008 to 6.0 percent in 2010 while under commercial sector the rate dropped from 4.2 in 2008 to 3.4 percent in 2009 and further down to 3.1 percent in 2010 (Tables 1, 9A and 9B).

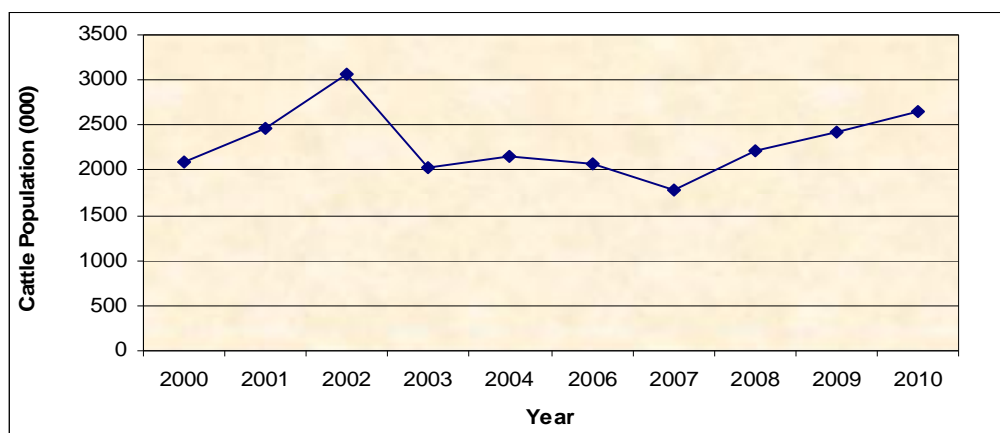
Generally, off-take rates were higher under the commercial sector than the traditional sector. The rate has significantly gone up to 9.0 percent in 2009 from 8.1 percent in 2008 and slightly went down to 8.0 in 2010 at national level (Tables 1, 9A and 9B). However, sales have increased by 12.5 percent during the agricultural seasons considered; from 218,348 to 245,731

with the average price per head also increasing from P2, 552 to P2, 970 at national level (Table 10).

Cattle birth rates were higher under the traditional sector as compared to the commercial sector. The rate went up to 55.9 percent in 2009 from 46.7 percent in 2008 and later dropped to 52.5 percent in 2010 at national level (Table 1, 9A and 9B).

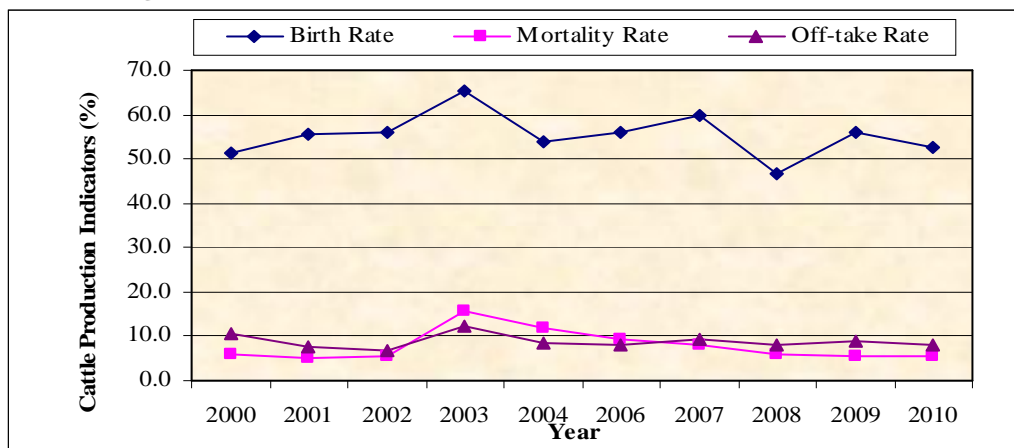
Graphical presentations of both cattle population and production indicators trends (traditional sector) are given as Figure 2.1a and Figure 2.1b.

These figures suggest an upward trend for cattle population since 2007; constant birth rates ranging between 50 and 60 percent except in 2003 and 2008, while off-take and mortality rates have remained below 10 percent except in 2003 and 2004.

2.2 Goats Holdings, Population and Production Indicators

Goats' holdings decreased from 91,172 in 2008 to 87,480 in 2009 and further down to 84,772 in 2010 at national level. On contrary, goats' population depicts a constant trend of about 1.9 million during the same period. In all these seasons the traditional sector dominated (Tables 1 & 11).

Birth rates decreased from 44.8 percent in 2008 to 43.4 percent in 2009 and further dropped to 41.6 percent in 2010 at national level. Similarly, death rates reduced from 23.5 percent in 2008 to 19.7 percent in 2009 and further down to 18.4 percent in 2010. On the other hand, off-take rates increased from 6.6 percent in 2008 to 6.9 percent in 2009 and later dropped to 5.7 percent in 2010 (Tables 1, 12A and 12B). This could be due to a significant decrease in goats' sales, particularly under the traditional sector. However, average price per goat slightly increased from P484 to P530 between 2009 and 2010 at national level (Table 13).

Figures 2.2a and 2.2b depict goats' population and production indicators trends (traditional sector). Goats' population shows a constant pattern ranging between 1.5 million and 1.9 million except in 2003; off-take rates are constantly below 10.0 percent; birth rates show a stable pattern ranging between 40 and 50 percent while death rates range between 20.0 and 30.0 percent except in 2001, 2007 and 2010.

Figure 2.2a: Goats Population Trend: 2000 - 2010

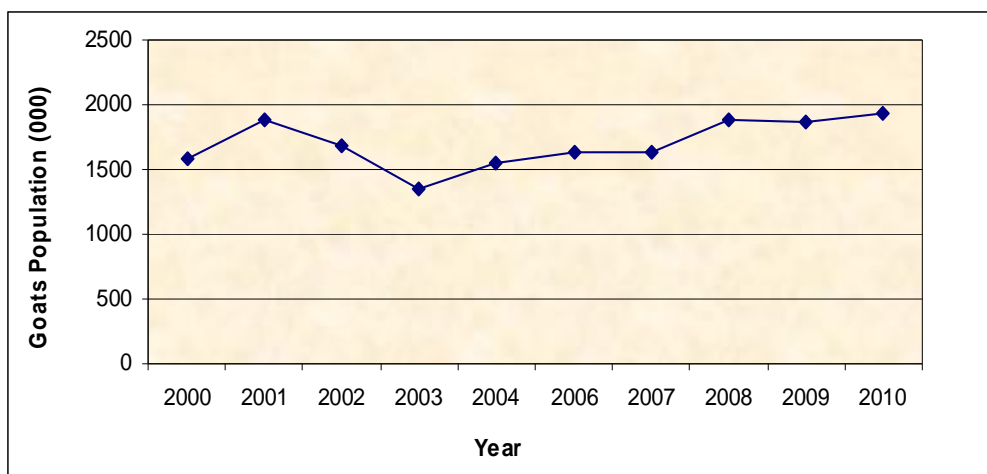
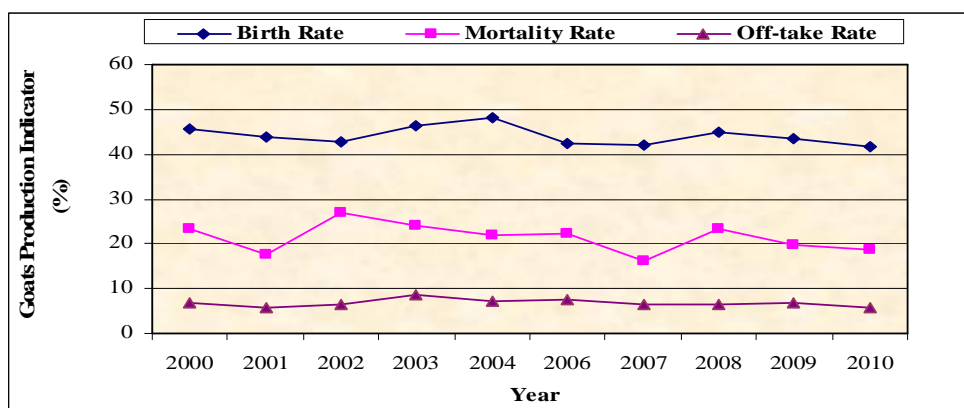


Figure 2.2b: Goats Production Indicators Trend: 2000 – 2010



2.3 Sheep Holdings, Population and Production Indicators

Sheep holdings decreased between 2008 and 2010 agricultural seasons; from 20,864 in 2008 to 20,636 in 2009 and further to 18,486 in 2010 at national level. Similarly, Sheep population followed the same pattern decreasing from 303,238 in 2008 to 293,395 in 2009 and further to 279,237 in 2010 at national level. However, the commercial sector displayed an increasing trend in both holdings and population while the reverse is true for the traditional sector (Tables 1 & 14).

Sheep production indicators showed a slightly downward trend between 2009 and 2010 agricultural seasons at national level. Off-take rate increased from 5.7 percent in 2008 to 7.9 percent in 2009 and later dropped to 5.1 percent in 2010 at national level. Birth and mortality rates followed the same pattern (Tables 1, 15A and 15B).

Graphical presentations of sheep population and production indicators trends (traditional sector) are displayed as Figure 2.3a and Figure 2.3b. The figures suggest a downward trend in sheep population; birth rates remained between 30 and 40 percent except in 2000; death rates remained between 10 and 20 percent; while off-take rates remained below 10 percent during the ten (10) year period.

Figure 2.3a: Sheep Population Trend (000): 2000 - 2010

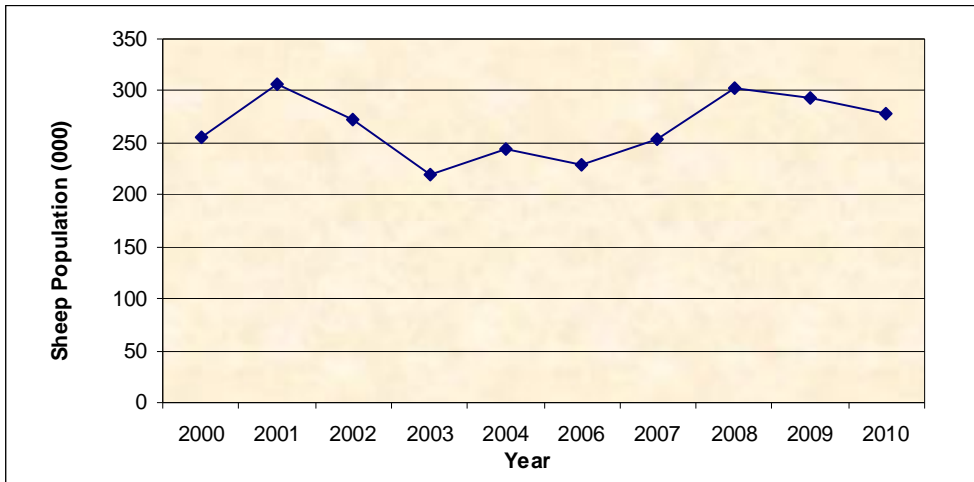
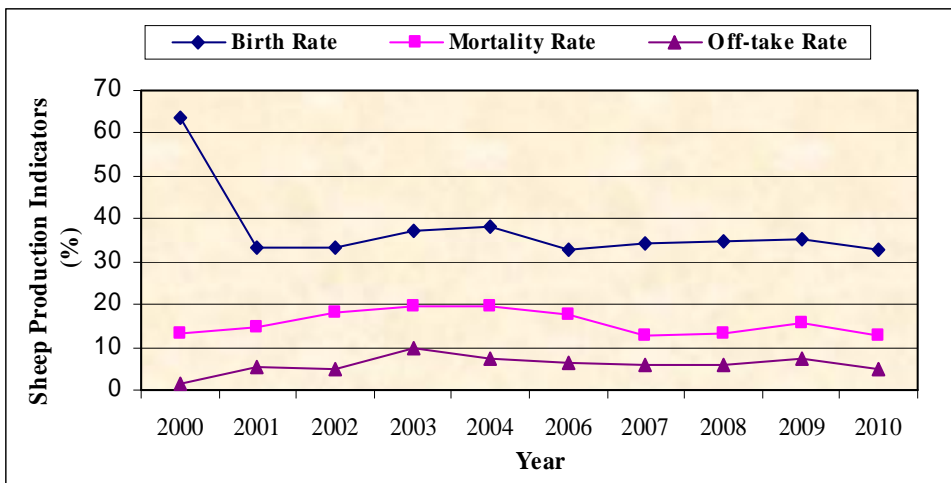


Figure 2.3b: Sheep Production Indicators Trends: 2000 - 2010



3.0 Crop Statistics

This section gives a summary of crop statistics for 2009 and 2010 cropping seasons. Crops covered include sorghum, maize, millet, beans/pulses, sunflower, groundnuts and others. However, the discussions will concentrate on four major crops namely sorghum, maize, millet and beans/pulses. Also note that percentages quoted in the write up do not form part of the reference tables.

3.1 Total Holdings, Total Area Planted and Harvested

Table 2 presents total land holdings and land area, total crop holdings, total area planted and total area harvested for 2007, 2008, 2009 and 2010 agricultural seasons.

The table suggests a significant decrease of 5.7 percent in number of farmers with land for planting (land holdings); from 80,947 in 2009 to 76,296 in 2010 at national level. Total land area¹ also reflected a decrease of 18.0; from 316,446 hectares to 259,490 hectares during the same period. Also noted is a 6.3, 3.6 and 10.1 percent decrease in both total crop holdings, area planted and harvested respectively. A higher percentage of these indicators are realized under the traditional sector (Table 2).

Graphical presentations of land holdings, holdings planted and holdings harvested trends is given as Figure 3.1a, while land area, area planted and harvested trend is presented as Figure 3.1b (Traditional sector).

Figure 3.1a: Land Holdings, Holdings Planted and Harvested Trends: 2000 - 2010

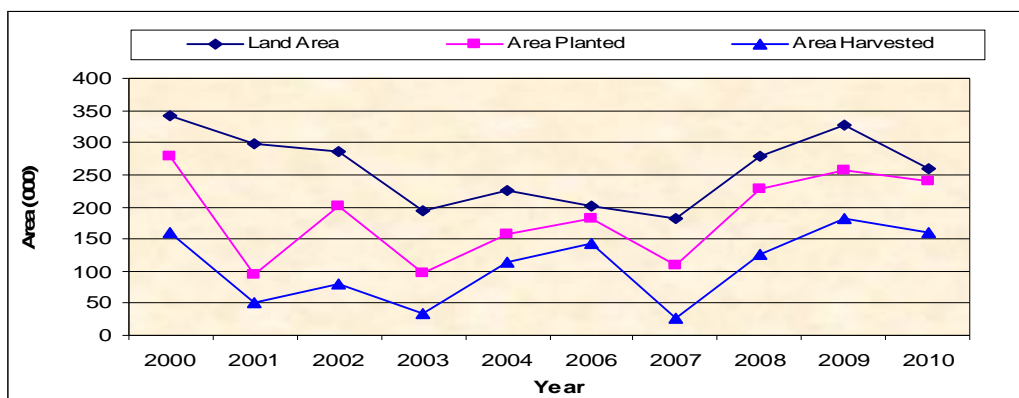
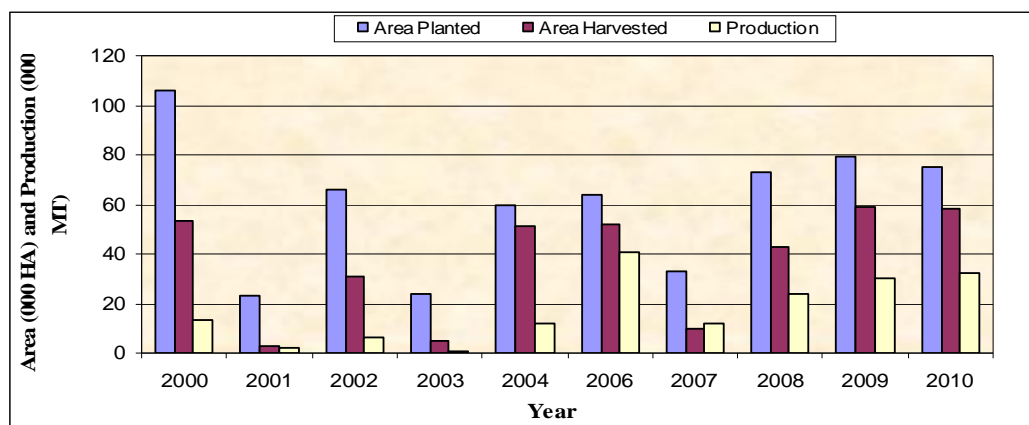


Figure 3.1b: Land Area, Area Planted and Harvested Trends: 2000 – 2010

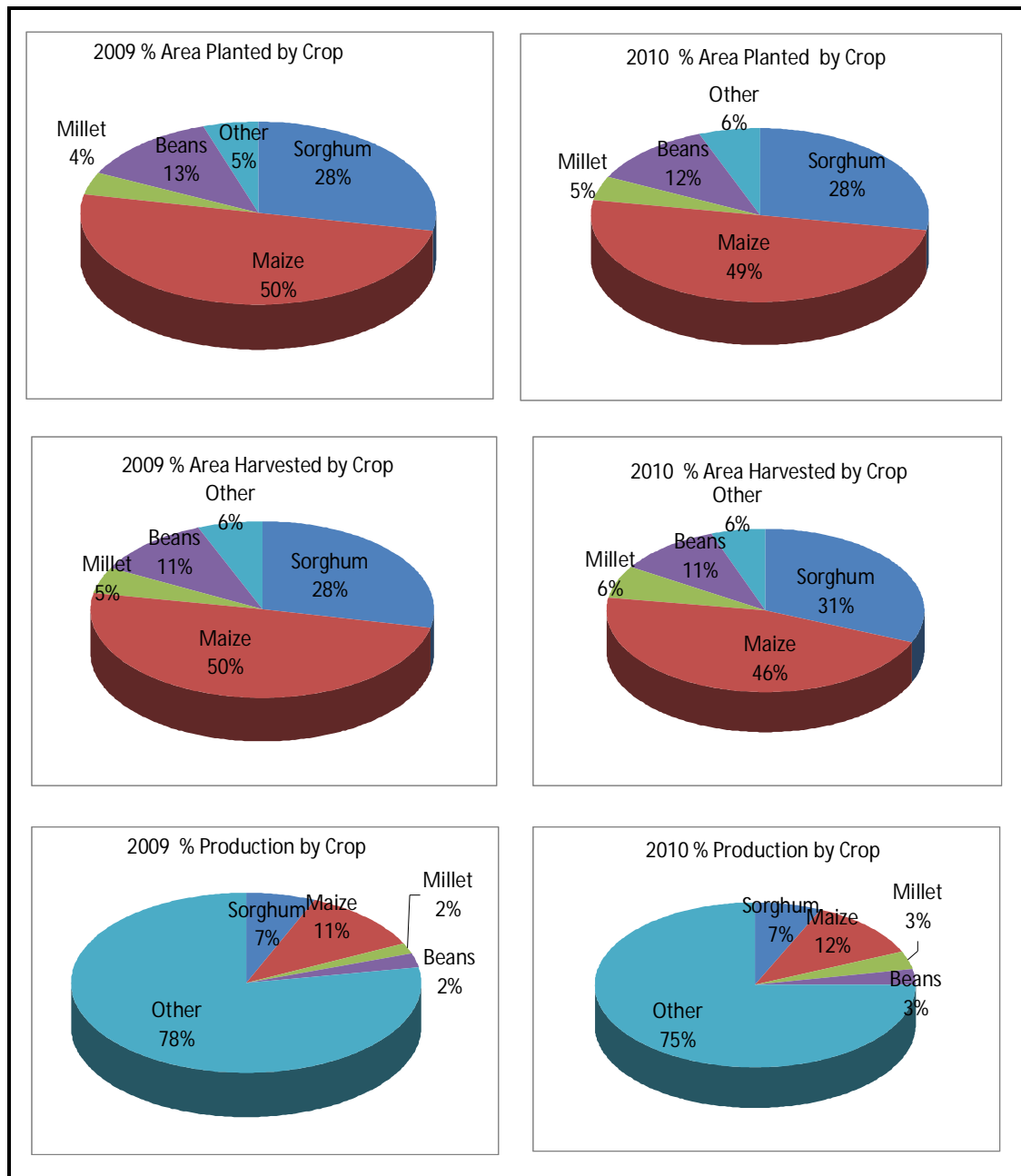


¹ Land area refers to area planted + fallow land area. Fallow land is land not ploughed during the survey season but was ploughed during the past year(s). For a piece of land to be regarded as fallow it has to stay at most five years without being ploughed. However, this differs from one region to the other. Land area may also increase or decrease depending on the extent of its utilization in a given agricultural season.

3.2 Crops Planted and Harvested

A comparison of the results between 2009 and 2010 agricultural seasons in Figure 3.2 suggest that a larger proportion of farmers tend to plant maize as compared to sorghum, so is the larger area planted and harvested followed by sorghum under the traditional sector. On contrary, production figures for four major crops (sorghum, maize, millet and pulses) are very low when compared to that of ‘other crops’ (mainly watermelons, melons, butter nuts etc).

Figure 3.2: Area Planted, Area Harvested and Production: 2009 and 2010



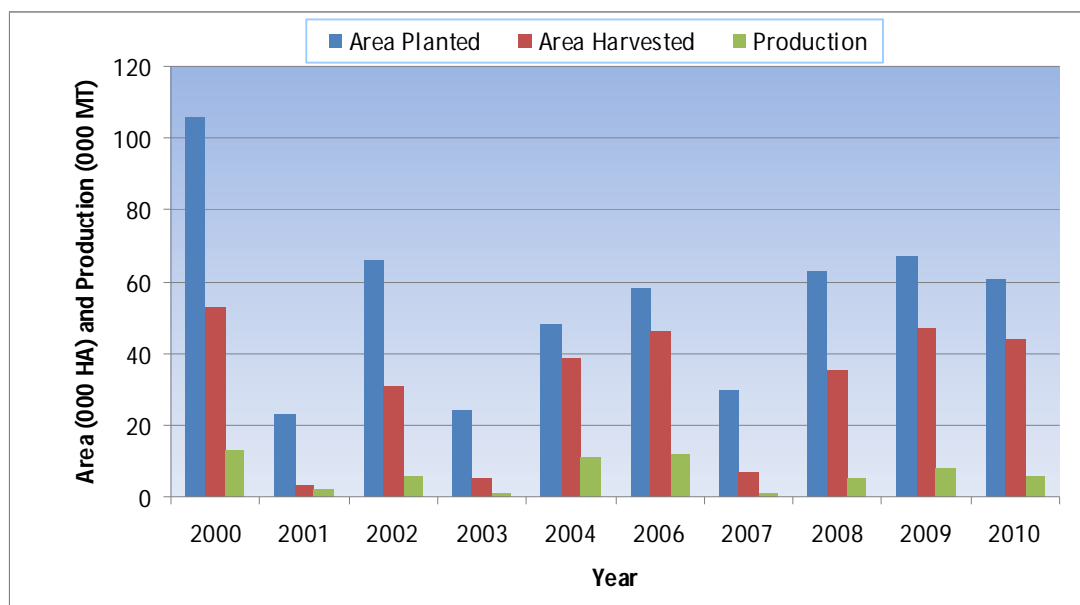
3.2a Sorghum

The number of farmers who planted sorghum declined by 9.4 percent; from 47,020 in 2009 to 42,612 in 2010 at national level. Similarly, area planted declined by 1.4 percent; from 76,383 hectares to 75,329 hectares. The same pattern was observed for area harvested during the same period. The decline was more pronounced under the traditional sector and the reverse true for the commercial sector (Table 2, 21A, 21B, 22A & 22B).

Sorghum production showed an upward trend over the past three years at national level, increasing from 23,632 metric tonnes in 2008 to 29,578 metric tons in 2009 and further to 32,767 metric tons in 2010. Commercial sector contributed more on total production particularly Pandamatenga area. The yield per hectare planted also showed an upward trend over the past three years; from 323 kg/ha in 2008 to 387 kg/ha in 2009 and further to 435 kg/ha in 2010 at national level. However, high significance increases in yields were realized under the commercial sector; from 1,855 kg/ha in 2008 to 1,867 kg/ha in 2010.

A graphical presentation of area planted, harvested and production trends for sorghum is presented in Figure 3.2a for traditional sector only.

Figure 3.2a: Sorghum: Area planted, Area Harvested and Production Trends: 2000 - 2010



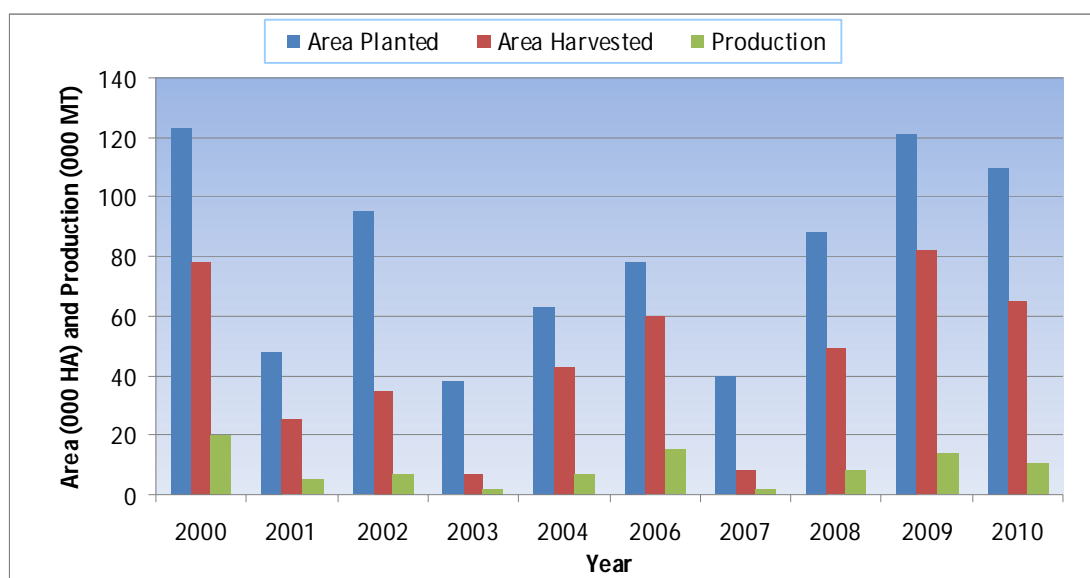
3.2b Maize

There has been a decline of 8.0 percent in the number of farmers who planted maize; from 74,891 hectares in 2009 to 68,882 hectares in 2010 at national level. Area planted also went down by 7.4 percent during the same period; from 118,932 to 110,081 hectares at national level. Similarly area harvested went down by 20.9 percent; from 82,710 hectares to 65,388 hectares during the same period (Tables 2, 21A, 21B, 22A & 22B). Of the total area planted (256,041 hectares) during the 2009 agricultural season, maize accounted for 47.3 percent and 45.4 percent in 2010 (242,422 hectares) while area harvested constituted 45.6 percent and 40.8 percent respectively of the total area harvested at national level.

Maize production went down by 47.4 percent to 10,572 Metric tonnes in 2010 from 20,093 Metric tones in 2009. Much of the reduction was realized under the commercial sector. Consequently, yield per hectare planted went down to 96 kg/ha in 2010 from 169 kg/ha in 2009 during the same period at national level, while for the commercial sector it reduced to 104 kg/ha from 22,089 kg/ha during the same period (Tables 2, 23A, 23B, 24A & 24B).

A graphical presentation of area planted, area harvested and production trends for **maize** is presented in figure 3.2b for the traditional sector only.

Figure 3.2b: Maize: Area Planted, Area Harvested and Production Trends: 2000 - 2010



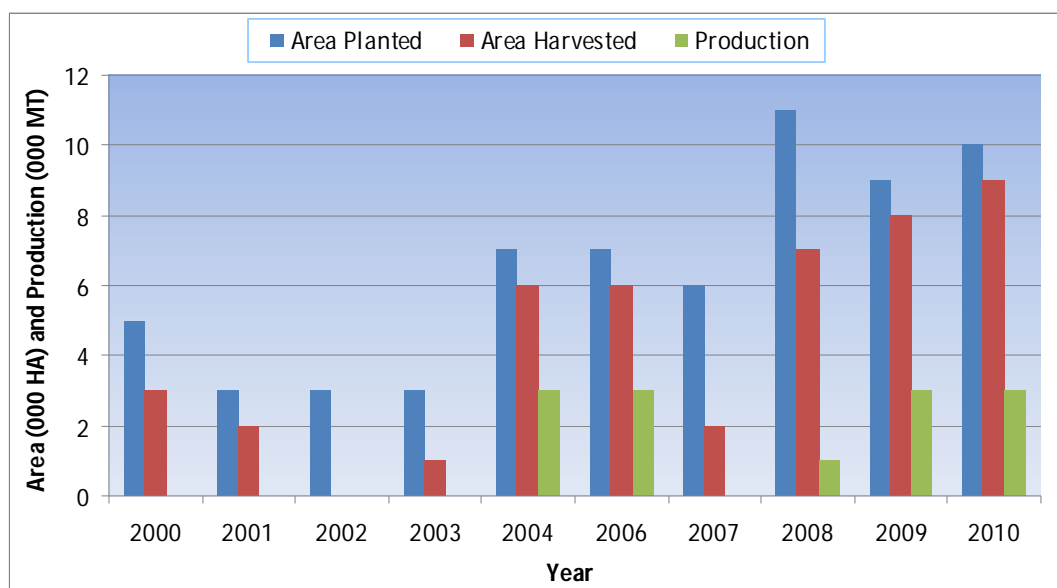
3.2c Millet

The total number of farmers who planted millet increased by 10.1 percent; from 16,529 in 2009 to 18,191 in 2010 at national level. Similarly area planted increased by 10.6 percent; from 9,801 hectares in 2009 to 10,842 hectares in 2010. Area harvested also increased by 16.5 percent; from 8,136 hectares in 2009 to 9,476 hectares in 2010 at national level (Tables 2, 21A, 21B, 22A & 22B).

Total production also showed a 23.1 percent increase; from 2,767 to 3,406 metric tons resulting in the increase in yield per hectare planted from 282 kg/ha in 2009 to 314 kg/ha in 2010 at national level (Tables 2, 23A, 23B, 24A & 24B).

A graphical presentation of area planted, area harvested and total production trends for millet is presented as Figure 3.2c for the traditional sector only.

NB: for the years 2000 – 2003 and 2007 figures for area harvested (2002 only) and production are too small to be rounded to a thousand.

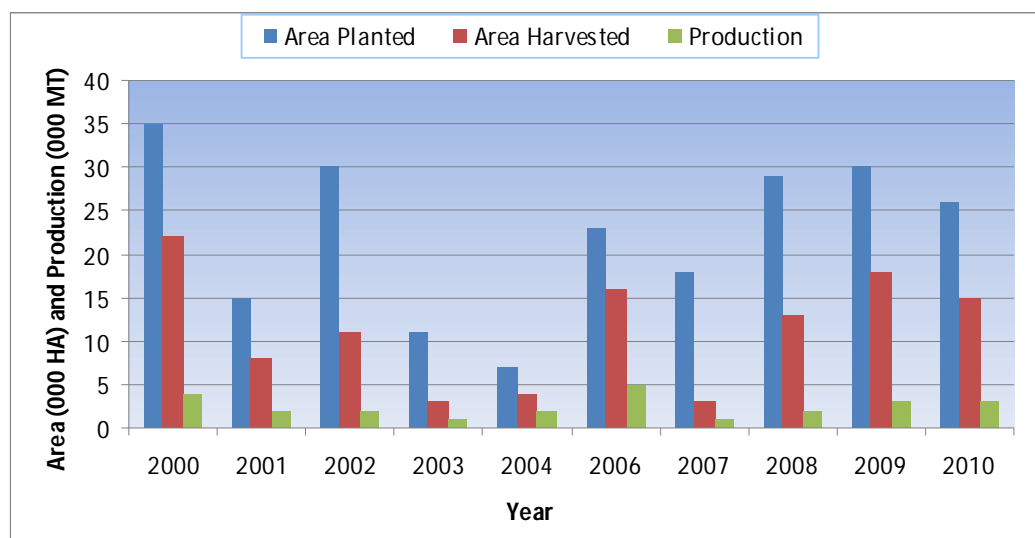
3.2d Beans/Pulses

There was a significant decrease of 9.9 percent in the number of farmers who planted beans/pulses; from 69,401 in 2009 to 62,522 in 2010. Similarly, area planted and harvested went down by 11.7 and 13.2 percent respectively during the same period (Tables 2, 21A, 21B, 22A & 22B). Of the total area harvested 94.0 and 86.1 percent were for traditional sector while 6.0 and 13.9 percent were for the commercial sector respectively.

Pulses production also dropped by 10.2 percent; from 4,313 metric tonnes in 2009 to 3,873 metric tonnes in 2010. However, the yield per hectare planted rose from 137 kg/ha in 2009 to 139 kg/ha in 2010 at national level (Tables 2, 23A, 23B, 24A & 24B).

A graphical presentation of area planted, area harvested and production trends for pulses is given as Figure 3.2d for the traditional sector only.
