

Introduction

This is the sixth edition of Tertiary Education Statistics Report, an annual publication of the Human Resource Development Council (HRDC) on the state of tertiary education in Botswana as at March 2020. The report presents real time statistics, data and indicators on the tertiary education landscape and plays a pivotal role in providing baseline data for planning and evidence based decision making for the education sector.

Objectives of the Report

The objectives of the 2020 report are to

- * Produce 2020 tertiary education indicators
- * Promote usage of timely statistics
- * Provide baseline statistics for the Education sector
- * Support planning and monitoring of the sector projects.

Methodology

The 2019/20 tertiary education institutional census covered a total of 44 Tertiary Education Institutions (TEIs); 40 Higher Education Institutions (HEIs) and four technical colleges under the Ministry of Tertiary Education, Science Research and Technology (MOTE). The 2019/20 data collection excluded data on short courses with the duration of up to six months. The data collection instrument comprised of a fourteen paged Microsoft excel template. TEIs were required to complete the templates from 1st of October 2019 to the 31st of March 2020. Other administrative records were sourced from key stakeholders such as Statistics Botswana, Botswana Examination Council (BEC) and Department of Tertiary Education Financing (DTEF).

Response Rate

The response rate from tertiary education institutions with respect to 2019/20 census is as per table 1 below;

Data Analysis

The data analysis was done using Microsoft Excel and Microsoft Access. The data was standardised using the International Standard Classification of Education (ISCED 2011) which is a standard classification designed to serve as a statistical framework for assembling, compiling and presenting comparable indicators and statistics of education both within individual countries and internationally. The required tertiary education indicators were then calculated and quality assured by Statistics Botswana.

Methodological Challenges

The following challenges were encountered in the course of data collection and analysis;

- * Data migration from ISCED 2011 to 2013
- * Late submission beyond the reference period
- * Data gaps/incomplete submission
- * Data inconsistency
- * Training of new focal persons

Participation in Tertiary Education

Overall Participation in 2020




Figure 1: Participation in Tertiary Education Enrolment in 2019/20.

Enrolment in Botswana's tertiary education has been grouped in two broad categories being the private and the public, admission to either of the two depends on the choices made by students. In 2020, a total of 56,666 students were pursing tertiary studies in Botswana: 37,061 (65.0%) in public tertiary institutions and 19,605 (35.0%) in private tertiary institutions. Of the 37,601 in public tertiary institutions, majority, 62 percent were enrolled in public universities. The Colleges of Education and Institute of Health Sciences were the least and accounted for 4 and 3 percent respectively. As for the private TEIs, the private universities accounted for 48 percent and the other private institutions had the remaining share of 52 percent. The distribution of total tertiary enrolment by source and type of institution is given in Figure 1.

It is evident from Figure 1 above that the public tertiary institutions attracted the majority of students, accounting for 65.0% of total enrolment in 2019/20, with the majority of them being enrolled in the public universities.

Trends in Total Enrolment

Overall, there has been an increase in tertiary education enrolments since 2009. Higher Education Institutions enrolled a total of 56,666 students during the 2019/20 academic year, thereby making an increase of 5.1% (2,736) from the previous academic year which had an enrolment of 53,930 students. The increase was mainly attributed to those enrolled in other private institutions for higher studies, which went up from 8,157 in 2019 to 10,162 in 2020 making an increase of 24.6 percent while enrolment in all the private TEIs actually increased by 2.3 percent. Figure 2 shows the tertiary education enrolment trends from 2009 to 2020.




Figure 3: Tertiary Education trends by total and broad categories (2013-2020)

Figure 3 shows that enrolment in public institutions had taken a somewhat upward trend in the last 3 years with an average increase of 4.9 percent annually from 33,689 in 2017/18 to 37,061 in 2019/20. On the other hand, the private institutions had a slight decrease from 19,761 to 19,605 during the same period.

Total Enrolment and Gender Parity Index for Tertiary Education




Figure 4: Trends of GPI in student enrolment 2013-2020

The Gender Parity Index (GPI) measures progress towards gender parity in education participation and learning opportunities available for women in relation to those available to men. From the total student enrolment of 56,666 in 2020, the gender parity index was at 1.6. The number indicates a higher number of females (0.6) than for males enrolled in the tertiary institutions. Figure 4 shows the GPI in student enrolment for Botswana from 2013 to date.

Trends in Gender parity Index for the period 2013 to 2020 shows that the index has been in favour of females. The highest index (1.6) was recorded in 2020, i.e. a total of hundred and sixty (160) females were enrolled against every one hundred (100) males. It also shows a slight increment of 0.1 compared to the previous year. The increase was mainly attributed to (among others) the increase of female students enrolled to study in technical colleges which went from 657(42.5 percent) in 2019 to 1,002 (50.4 percent) in 2020.

The data presented in table 2 highlights the distribution of students among the different types of higher education providers. From the table, it is clear that the universities (both private and public) dominate the overall share of enrolments in higher education. Majority of the students (22,830) were enrolled in public universities which is made up of Botswana University of Agriculture and Natural Resources (BUAN), Botswana Open University (BOU), Botswana International University of Science and Technology (BIUST) and University of Botswana (UB). The lowest enrolment, (1,229) was recorded from the six public Institute of Health Sciences. Female enrolment was 34,505 and accounted for almost 61 percent of the total enrolment. A relatively higher share of female enrolment than male enrolment was observed across all the different types of institutions.

The majority of students (91 percent) were enrolled at under graduate level, and only four percent of the total enrolment constituted master's degree and PHD combined, (with PHD enrolment at 0.3 percent (151students) of which 64 were females).

Enrolment by ISCED field of Education




Figure 5: 2020 Enrolment by Field of Education

In order to ensure data international comparability, enrolments were classified into the eight standard broad fields of education in accordance with the ISCED 2011 as per figure 5 below;

The Social Sciences, Business and Law field of education had the highest concentration of students constituting 41 percent of the total student population. Education is the second major field with 15 percent. Technology, Engineering and Mathematics (STEM) area (Engineering and Science combined), accounted for 24 percent (13% Engineering and 11% Science) of the enrolment. The Engineering and Science programmes included four and three sub streams from science and engineering respectively, covering computing, mathematics and statistics, computer engineering and engineering trades. Agriculture and Services streams were the lowest and accounted for 2 percent each of the total student population. Table 5 below shows the total number of students enrolled by different eight standard broad fields of education.



Sex distribution by ISCED Fields of Education

Figure 6 shows a relatively higher share of female enrolment than male across all the fields except for Agriculture, Humanities, Science and Engineering fields. Engineering, Manufacturing & Construction had the lowest proportion of females. The highest number of females were enrolled in education programmes. Agriculture, humanities and arts streams show a different picture with an approximate balance between both sexes.



Sponsorship

Student Enrolment by Sponsorship type

The 2020 data had revealed that the government is the main sponsor of tertiary education in Botswana. This could be necessitated by the existing policies which provides for student's sponsorship up to tertiary (undergraduate) level. Of the 56,666 students enrolled in tertiary education institutions in 2020, 39,446 (70%) were on government sponsorship while only 12,646 (22%) and 4,574 (8%) were on self and other entities sponsorships respectively. Figure 7 below presents 2020 student enrolment by sponsorship type.

Trends of Tertiary Students on Government sponsorship




Figure 8: Trends of Tertiary Students on Government sponsorship

Figure 8 shows the trends in the number of students sponsored by the government between 2008/9 and 2019/20.

Figure 8 indicates that the number of tertiary education students on Government sponsorship increased from 28,976 in 2008/09 to 48,703 in 2012/13. This constituted a 68.1 percent increase over the five-year period. Thereafter, the number of tertiary education students on Government sponsorship gradually decreased from 48,703 in 2012/13 to 38,806 in 2016/17. In 2020, the total number of sponsored students was 39,446.

Study Mode

Enrolment by study mode




Figure 9: Student Enrolment by study mode (2020)

Pedagogically, blended models of learning to combine face-to face, part-time and distance experiences (e.g. lectures and tutorials supported by podcasts, online discussions, materials and activities) have led to teaching methods and resources that blur the boundaries between campusbased and distance delivery models (Lefoe and Albury 2004; Lefoe and Hedberg 2006). Of recent, study mode is considered to be a key attribute in choosing the programmes of study, as such universities have diversified their means of delivering education and increased the use of online delivery mode. Analysis of the study mode for the 56, 666 students enrolled in TEIs was as per figure 9 below:

The most preferred study mode was full time, followed by distance and part-time. Colleges of education and Institutes of health sciences across the country use only one mode being the fulltime mode. It should be noted that the 6,412 enrolled on distance mode under public universities were all from the Botswana Open University.

Inbound Students

Enrolment by Country of Origin

The total number of foreign national students enrolled in Botswana's Tertiary Institutions is one thousand, two hundred and four (12O4). These foreign students come from 48 different countries across the globe. Table 8 presents the number of foreign students from tertiary education institutions by country of origin. According to the table, the highest share of students come from neighbouring SADC countries of which Zimbabwe constitutes 31.7 percent of the total, followed by Eswatini at 9.3 percent, Lesotho at 9.1 percent and Zambia at 8.4 percent.

Inbound Mobility Ratio

Inbound Mobility Ratio (IMR) is calculated as the number of students from abroad studying in a given country, as a percentage of the total tertiary enrolment in that country. The indicator is used to gauge the extent of the number of students studying in the country from abroad and it sometimes gives an indication of the value attached to the quality of a country's tertiary institutions by other countries. In 2020 the IMR for Botswana was at 2.1 percent indicating a very low inflow of students from other countries.

Gross Enrolment Ratio

Gross Enrolment Ratio (GER) for tertiary education is a statistical measure used to determine the ratio of the number of students enrolled in a country's tertiary institutions to those in the tertiary reference age. It is an indicator used to quantify level of participation in tertiary education. Botswana's GER (2020) as calculated for the 18-24 population age group was 19.5 percent which is 0.9 percentage point increase from the previous year. Despite the indicator being below the prorated target set by the government in 2010, there is a positive step towards increasing the level of educational attainment in the country. Table 9 below presents the total student enrolment, projected 18-24 age population cohort and the calculated GER for the past thirteen years to date.




Figure 10: Gross Enrolment ratio (Tertiary) Comparisons

Sub-Saharan Africa had the GER of less than 10 percent in the last 10 years. Compared to other Sub-Saharan Africa countries, Botswana is among those with GER higher than the benchmarked average. Mauritius is one of the few from Sub-Saharan Africa and the continent to have a significantly higher GER of more than 45 percent in the past few years.

Transition

Transition from Basic to Tertiary Education

Before transiting from basic education to tertiary education, students have to complete the highest basic education level (Senior Secondary School) and go through a syllabus – based assessment called Botswana General Certificate of Secondary Education (BGCSE) and other equivalent assessments. After completing BGCSE and or its equivalent, the expectation is that successful students will proceed to tertiary education level and be part of the new intake into tertiary institutions. Table 10 presents the total number of students who sat for the BGCSE in the respective years.





Figure 11: Composition of 2019 BGCSE Candidates

In 2019 a total of 36,508 candidates sat for the BGCSE examination of which majority 21,130 (58%) were from Government schools, 8,680 (24%) from Botswana Open University, 3,976 (11%) Botswana Examination Council (BEC) Centre and 2,722 (7%) from Private schools as depicted in Figure 7 above

New Intake

The new intake is the total number of new students admitted into tertiary education for the very first time in a given year. The total number of new intake for the academic year 2019/20 stood at 11,105. The number only included those who enrolled for undergraduate level, i.e from certificates to Bachelor's degree programmes and thus excludes new intake in all the post graduate programmes.

As depicted in figure 12, the new intake into tertiary education has been fluctuating significantly from 2014 to date. The 2019/20 intake shows a drop from the 18,548 recorded in 2018/19 to 11,105 recorded in 2019/20. The figure also shows that since 2014,the majority of the new intake were admitted into public tertiary institutions, 66.4 percent in 2019. Transition Rate

Using the 2019 new intake and the 2018 total number of BGCSE candidates (32,470) as a proxy to calculate the Transition rate, the data shows that only 34.2 percent of the BGCSE candidates managed to transit to tertiary education. This is a decrease of 16.8 percent from the 2018/19 transition rate which stood at 51.0 percent.

Tertiary Education Graduates

Tertiary graduates are in two folds; those who completed their tertiary education within the reference period as first timers and those graduating within the same period but had graduated from tertiary education at least once in their lifetime, for example, post graduates.




Figure 13: Tertiary Education Graduates trends 2009-2018

Botswana's tertiary education trends from the year 2009 to 2019 are shown as per figure 13. In 2019, 11,963 graduated from tertiary education institutions in Botswana, which is 2.9 percent more than in 2018. The relatively lower number of graduates in Botswana, at least to some extent, reflects a longer average course length more especially at the undergraduate level which has the highest proportion of tertiary enrolment.

Graduation Rate

The graduation rate was 82.1 percent, which is 2.3 percent from the graduate rate of 79.8 percent recorded in the previous year.

Graduates by Qualification level




Figure 14: Graduates by the level of Qualification

When comparing the distribution of graduates by qualification level, it could be seen that the undergraduates form the highest share of the 2O2O tertiary education graduates (97 percent). The Bachelor's degree was the highest with 47 percent, with diploma and certificate with a share of 39 and 11 percent respectively. The total proportion share of post graduates was only 3 percent, with Doctor of Philosophy accounting for a significantly lower share of 0.2 percent.




Figure 15: 2019 Graduates by ISCED Fields of Education

Budget




Figure 16: 2019/20 Ministerial Recurrent Budget (Billion Pula)

The total Ministerial Recurrent Budget for financial year 2019/2020 was P46.99 (billion). Ministry of Basic Education was allocated the largest share of the budget with P8.24 (billion), followed by Ministry of Health and Wellness with P7.63 (billion). Other Ministries which were allocated significant amounts of the Ministerial Recurrent budget are: Ministry of Defence, Justice and Security with P6.86 (billion) and Ministry of Local Government and Rural Development with P6.43 (billion). Figure 16 is a presentation of the 2019/20 Ministerial Recurrent Budget.

Ministry of Tertiary Education, Research, Science and Technology was allocated a budget of P4.54 (billion). This allocation mainly provided for tertiary education student's sponsorship and tertiary education public institution's subventions, mainly to University of Botswana, Botswana International University of Science and Technology, Botswana Open University and Botswana University of Agriculture and Natural Resources (Ministry of Finance and Economic Development, 2019).
