# MONTHLY DIGEST STATISTICS BOTSWANA

This International Merchandise Trade Statistics (IMTS) Monthly Digest presents statistics on Botswana's total imports and exports of goods as at the end of January 2014. Data for imports and exports of goods is currently complete up to December 2013. Data for January 2014 is from borders with automated facilities only, constituting about 98 percent of total trade in value terms.

Since Statistics Botswana receives new data on monthly basis, and there is continuous data editing as various tables and reports are produced, the database is therefore updated from time to time. As a result of editing and revision of data, figures on previous Monthly Digests (for subsequent months) and that on the current Monthly Digest may differ. As from January 2014 Monthly Digest onwards, a table referred to as Table A will be included, showing data revision for the past three months. This will be showing how data has been revised from the previous digest to the current one.

This monthly digest presents summaries of Total Merchandise Trade from the first quarter of 2008 to January 2014 as presented on Table 1. Trade by Principal Commodity groups is presented on Tables 2.1 and 2.2 for imports and exports, respectively, giving data from the first quarter of 2009 to the month under review. Table 2.3 give trade on diamonds only. Direction of trade is given for the most recent twelve months and this appears on Tables 3.1 and 3.2 for imports and exports respectively.

Three graphical presentations appear in this digest. Chart 1 shows imports, total exports and trade balance from January 2008 to January 2014 while Charts 2.1 and 2.2 show Principal Commodity groups for major imports and major exports respectively, for January 2014 only.

In the current digest, data for March, April and May 2013 have been added to the disaggregation process, meaning that diamonds imports for March 2013 up to January 2014 only, are those that were imported into Botswana for processing (polishing and cutting) only, and excludes those coming in for aggregation leading to re-export. Exports for these months comprise exports of Botswana diamonds plus exports from diamond processing companies operating in Botswana.

Sorting out Botswana diamonds trade from the aggregation process is riddled with challenges, as extra information is needed to do so. As a result revision of the database to as far back as July 2012 when Diamond Trading Company International (DTCI) operations relocated to Gaborone will be done gradually and is expected to be completed by the end of June 2014. Users will however be informed of progress in the impending monthly digests.

Statistics on commodities that were mostly traded during the most recent two months, December 2013 and January 2014 in this case, appear on Tables 4.1 (A) \& (B) for imports while exports are presented on Tables 4.2 (A) \& (B). Trade at Chapter Level (2 digits Harmonized Commodity Description \& Coding System) appears on Table 5, presenting data for December 2013 and January 2014.

Table 1 distinguishes domestic exports from re-exports while other tables give total exports, which is the sum of the two.

We sincerely thank all stakeholders involved in the formulation of this monthly digest, their continued support and feedback, as we strive to better serve Batswana and all other important users of our services.

### 1.0 Total Trade

Total merchandise trade as presented in this section refers to imports, domestic exports and re-exports as well as trade balance.

### 1.0.1 Data Revision

It should also be noted that IMTS is compiled using date of recording of trade as opposed to date of assessment of goods by customs. This means that as goods cross the border, trade is recorded and this is the reference month that will be used for compilation of IMTS. Some of these goods may however be held by customs for some time pending final assessment for tax or duty purposes. If final assessment is done two or three months, or even more, after goods had crossed the border, the affected trade will then update trade for the particular month when the goods crossed the border, therefore it does not form part of trade for the month during which final assessment was done. This is mostly common with imports. Data revision for the month preceding the one under review will be much high as compared to the other months and this will be because it also includes incorporation of data from manual border posts.

Discussions on total trade (Section 1) are based on Table 1.

### 1.1 Imports

Discussions on imports are based on cost, freight and insurance (cif) value. January 2014 total imports were valued at P3, 573.9 million, showing a decrease of 24.5 percent (P1, 162.4 million) from the December 2013 value of P4, 736.3 million. In comparison to the January 2013 total imports which recorded P6, 022.8 million, the January 2014 value decreased by 40.7 percent (P2, 448.8 million).

### 1.2 Total Exports

In January 2014 total exports were valued at P4, 294.9 million, an increase of 18.2 percent (P661.0 million) from the December 2013 value of P3, 633.9 million. The January 2014 total exports decreased by 19.4 percent (P1, 035.3 million) from the total value of exports recorded in Janvary 2013, which stood at P5, 330.2 million.

### 1.3 Trade Balance

January 2014 recorded a trade surplus of P721.0 million.
Chart 1: Total Merchandise Trade - January 2008 to January 2014 (Million PULA)


Chart 1 shows trade surplus in January 2014. It should be noted that trade balance is largely dependent on the value of diamonds traded as these are associated with high values.

### 2.0 Trade by Principal Commodities

Principal commodity groups refer to selections of related commodities grouped together to form major groups. Commodities forming a group may be of related chapters, for example; "Machinery \& Electrical Equipment" which combines machines and electrical appliances; "Vehicles \& Transport Equipment" which combines vehicles and other equipment used for transport purposes.

In some cases it becomes challenging to come up with further groups of related chapters or commodities. This occurs when commodity groupings' contributions to the total, are minimal. In such cases, the commodities are grouped together under the general category called "Other".

### 2.1 Principal Imports

Imports by Principal Commodity Groups together with the associated percentage distributions, appear on Table 2.1, covering the first quarter of 2009 to January 2014. Percentage distributions are however only shown for 2010, 2011, 2012 and 2013 totals, as well as for January 2014. Chart 2.1 gives graphical presentation of Principal Import Commodity groups for January 2014 only.

Composition of imports by principal commodities for January 2014 shows that Fuel contributed 20.2 percent (P722.5 million) to total imports (P3, 573.9 million) during the month, followed by Machinery \& Electrical Equipment and Food, Beverages \& Tobacco with 16.8 percent (P598.7 million) and 14.0 percent (P501.2 million) respectively. Vehicles \& Transport Equipment contributed 13.1 percent(P467.8 million), followed by Chemicals \& Rubber Products with a contribution of 12.6 percent (P450.5 million) while Diamonds and Metal \& Metal Products contributed 7.2 percent (P258.8 million) and 4.9 percent (P176.6 million) respectively, to total imports during January 2014.

### 2.2 Principal Exports

January 2014 total exports were valued at P4, 294.9 million, with 83.2 percent (P3, 573.3 million) attributed to exports of Diamonds. The diamond trade is for both rough and polished diamonds and Table 2.3 gives trade in diamonds at a disaggregated level from the first Quarter of 2009 to January 2014. It should be noted that diamond exports for March 2013 to January 2014 are for rough diamonds originating from Botswana plus those from diamonds processing companies only. Re-exports of diamonds from aggregation process are not inclusive in March 2013 to January 2014 data.

Copper/Nickel, Machinery \& Electrical Equipment and Salt \& Soda Ash contributed 8.9 percent (P383.6 million), 1.3 percent (P53.8 million) and 1.0 percent (P41.8 million) respectively, to total exports during the month under review.

Percentage distributions for major export groups can be observed on Table 2.2 while Chart $\mathbf{2 . 2}$ gives the graphical presentation for January 2014 only. It should however be noted that total exports discussed here are the sum of domestic exports and re-exports.

### 3.0 Trade by Regional and Major Partners

Direction of trade gives imports by source while exports are presented by destination. Only major trading partners are considered individually, while smaller trading partners are grouped together under a general category. Data for the most recent twelve months appear on Table 3.1 for imports and Table 3.2 for exports.

### 3.1 Imports by Region and Major Trading Partners

Imports for January 2014 were valued at P3, 573.9 million, with 77.0 percent (P2, 752.3 million) coming from South Africa. The European Union (EU) supplied imports valued at P339.2 million during January 2014, representing 9.5 percent of total imports. Imports from the European Union (EU) are mainly from Belgium, contributing 5.0 percent (P177.9 million), followed by Germany with 1.9 percent ( P 68.2 million) of total imports during the month under review.

Imports from Asia were valued at P244.7 million in January 2014, representing 6.8 percent of total imports. Imports from Asia were mainly from Israel, contributing 2.8 percent ( P 98.6 million), followed by China with a contribution of 1.7 percent (P60.8 million) to total imports into Botswana during the month under review.

Imports at regional and country level (for selected countries) are presented on Table 3.1; however, percentage distributions do not form part of this table.

### 3.2 Exports by Region and Major Partner Countries

Total exports for January 2014 were valued at P4, 294.9 million, with 16.2 percent ( P 695.5 million) of this value destined to SADC. South Africa, Namibia and Zimbabwe received 10.0 percent ( P 430.2 million), 3.3 percent (P139.6 million) and 1.8 percent (P77.8 million) respectively, of Botswana exports during the month under review.

Exports destined to the EU were valued at P1, 578.4 million, representing 36.7 percent of total exports during the period under review. Belgium alone received 32.9 percent (P1, 412.6 million) of total exports during January 2014.

Exports destined to Asia were valued at P1, 696.9 million, which is 39.5 percent of total exports. India received most of exports destined to Asia, having received 14.9 percent ( P 642.0 million) while Israel received 8.2 percent (P351.3 million). United Arab Emirates and Hong Kong received 5.9 percent ( P 254.0 million) and 3.2 percent (P135.9 million) respectively, of total exports during January 2014.

Exports to Switzerland were valued at P1 18.8 million, representing 2.8 percent. Norway and the United States of America received 2.2 percent (P93.4 million) and 1.8 percent (P75.3 million) respectively.

Other destinations for exports can be observed on Table 3.2; however, percentage distributions do not form part of the table.

### 6.0 Technical Notes

Botswana International Merchandise Trade Statistics are compiled by International Merchandise Trade Statistics Section of Statistics Botswana. External trade statistics here refers to trade in goods only (International Merchandise Trade Statistics). Trade statistics in services are not compiled by this unit. The primary source of External Trade data is Customs \& Excise Division which is part of Botswana Unified Revenue Service. Customs is responsible for data capture for both computerized and manual borders and the monthly raw data files are transferred to Statistics Botswana for data processing, in electronic form.

Up to April 2009 Monthly Digest, Botswana was practicing Relaxed Special Trade Type. The Relaxed Special Trade Type takes in to account goods that are exported or imported for inward or outward customs processing while the Strict Special Trade Type does not include the same.

In June 2009, the Botswana External Trade database was revised to cater for General Trade Type as per the United Nations Statistics Division recommendations. The General Trade Type gives a complete coverage of External Trade as compared to the Special Trade Type.

Imports are valued CIF (cost, insurance \& freight) while exports are valued FOB (free on board). The value of imports includes transport and insurance costs to the importing country. Exports value consists only of the value of goods as they leave the exporting country. Goods are valued as at the time they cross the border of the exporting country.

### 6.1 Definitions used

Domestic Exports: Goods of Botswana origin being exported permanently out of Botswana for consumption in the outside world.

Re-Exports: Goods that were initially imported for local consumption and are now being exported permanently out of the country or goods which were exported in the same condition as imported or after undergoing minor transformation which leaves them not substantially changed.

Imports: Goods imported from the outside world, into Botswana, for local consumption.
Trade Balance (Net Export): This refers to the total value of goods exported minus the total value of goods imported by a given economy in a given period of time. A positive trade balance (trade surplus) indicates that a country is exporting more in value terms than it is importing. A negative trade balance (trade deficit) indicates that the country importing more than it is exporting.
