Botswana Food Imports August 2022

In August 2022, Botswana's total imports were valued at **P6,926,262,137**. In this amount, the share of Food Imports was **P1,016,151,639** (14.7 percent). Cereals accounted for the largest share of Food Imports at 18.3 percent. Beverages, Spirits & Vinegar and Preparations of cereals, flour, starch or milk; pastry cooks' products followed with 14.8 percent and 9.3 percent respectively.


Among the Cereals; maize (corn), other than seed contributed 40.4 percent. Rice, semi-milled or wholly milled, whether or not polished or glazed and Wheat and meslin, other than durum wheat or seed followed with 30.8 percent and 26.7 percent respectively.

Beverages fermented; e.g. cider, perry, mead, sake accounted for 27.1 percent of Beverages and Vinegar. Beer made from malt and Non-alcoholic beverages other than non-alcoholic beer, not including fruit or vegetable juices followed with 26.4 percent and 16.7 percent respectively.
