BOTSWANA FOOD IMPORTS January 2023

Table 1 shows that Botswana's total imports were valued at **P 5,832,464,919.3** during the month of January 2023. The share of food imports during the period was **P871**, **593**, **582.3**, representing 14.9 percent of total imports. Cereals accounted for most imported food items at 21.5 percent. This was followed by Beverages, Spirits & Vinegar and Preparations of vegetables, fruit, nuts or other parts of plants at 19.0 and 8.9 percent respectively.

A further breakdown of the cereals chapter shows that maize (corn), other than seed accounted for 48.9 percent, whereas wheat and meslin, other than durum wheat recorded 33.9 percent as reflected in **Table 2a** below. All the other products within the cereals chapter assumed the remaining 17.2 percent.

Within the Beverages, Spirits & Vinegar chapter, the most imported commodity was beer made from malt, accounting for 35.4 percent. Beverages, fermented; (e.g. cider, perry, mead, sake) followed with a contribution of 26.1 percent, while Non-alcoholic beverages; other than non-alcoholic beer, not including fruit or vegetable juices made a contribution of 12.7 percent (refer to **Table 2b**). All the other products in this chapter assumed the remaining 25.8 percent.


