

Botswana's total imports were valued at **P 8,066,571,674** in July 2022. In this amount, Food imports contributed **P938**, **486,809** translating to 11.6 percent. During the month under review, Cereals accounted for 17.0 percent of Food imports. Sugars & Sugar Confectionery and Beverages, Spirits & Vinegar followed with 16.7 percent and 11.5 percent respectively.

In July 2022, Maize (corn), other than seed were the most imported among Cereals at 44.4 percent. Wheat and meslin, other than durum wheat, other than seed and Rice, semi-milled or wholly milled, whether or not polished or glazed followed with 36.6 percent and 17.5 respectively.


Among Sugars & Sugar Confectionery the most imported types were Sucrose, chemically pure, in solid form, not containing added flavouring or colouring matter accounting for 52.1 percent. Cane sugar, raw, in solid form, not containing added flavouring or colouring matter followed with a contributions of 17.0 percent.
