1.0 INTRODUCTION

1.1 Tertiary Education Report

The Human Resource Development Council (HRDC) Strategic Plan of 2016-2021 has endorsed the production of the Tertiary Education Statistics Report on an annual basis. The report presents real time statistics, data and indicators on Botswana's tertiary education landscape. It provides baseline data for planning and evidence based decision making for the education sector. It further provides summaries of the information received from registered Tertiary Education Institutions (TEIs) under Botswana Qualifications Authority (BQA). Data collected is mainly on student and staff for the academic year 2018/19 (July 2018 to June 2019). The 2018/19 report provides statistical information on student enrolment, graduation, certification, institutional staff as well as other relevant information from the education and training entities. It includes key financial statistics pertaining to total government expenditures on tertiary education for the period 2018/19. Indicators of educational development such as institution density, gender parity index, gross enrolment ratio and unit cost are calculated from the data. These indicators are useful for further research in the development of the education sector.

The data and statistics contained herein has been quality assured and endorsed by Statistics Botswana (SB), a body responsible for the provision of national statistics. The report is also a bench mark for reporting to the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organisation (UNESCO), through the UNESCO Institute for Statistics (UIS). The UIS is the statistical office of UNESCO and it is the United Nations (UN) depository for global statistics in the fields of education, science and technology, culture and communication. As such the office requires data and information on an annual basis from all member states.

1.2 Objectives of the Report

The objectives of the 2019 report are to:

- a) Produce 2019 tertiary education indicators
- b) Promote usage of timely statistics
- c) Provide baseline statistics for the Education sector
- d) Support planning and monitoring of the sector projects.

2.0 METHODOLOGY

The methodology used for the 2018/19 census describes the design, data collection method, procedures as well as techniques used to collect and analyse data for the report. The census was undertaken from the 1st of October 2018 to the 31st May 2019.

2.1 Scope




Figure 1: Composition of the 2018/19 Tertiary Education Census participants

The 2018/19 tertiary education institutional census covered a total of 44 tertiary education institutions (both private and public) which was made up of 40 Higher Education Institutions (HEIs) and four Technical Colleges. The collection excluded data on short courses with the duration of up to six months. Figure 1 is a pictorial presentation of tertiary education institutions that took part in the 2018/19 census.

2.2 Data collection Instruments

The data collection instrument comprised of a fourteen paged Microsoft excel template. Tertiary Education Institutions were required to complete the templates during the first semester of the academic year and submit to HRDC. The data collected included academic and non-academic staff, student's enrolment, programmes, examination results, disability information, scholarship, finance and Public Institutions budgets/allocation among others. Administrative records on education related statistics were sourced from key stakeholders such as Statistics Botswana, Botswana Examination Council (BEC) and Department of Tertiary Education Financing (DTEF).

2.3 Response Rate

The response rate from tertiary institutions with respect to 2018/19 census is reflected in table 1 below:

2.4 Confidentiality of Information Collected

All the information collected in the 2018/19 census was used only for compiling statistics and no individual personal information was divulged. Individual personal information was removed in the processing of data to ensure that it could not be deduced from statistics contained in detailed tabulations. This was done to protect the confidentiality of students and staff personal information provided by institutions.

2.5 Data Analysis

The data was analysed using Microsoft Excel and Microsoft Access. The data was standardised using the International Standard Classification of Education (ISCED 2011) which is a standard classification designed to serve as a statistical framework for assembling, compiling and presenting comparable indicators and statistics of education both within individual countries and internationally. The required tertiary education indicators were then calculated and quality assured by Statistics Botswana.

2.6 Methodological Challenges

The following challenges were encountered in the course of data collection;

- Data inconsistency
- Data gaps/ incomplete submission
- Late submission beyond the reference period
- Change of focal persons in other institutions

These delayed the production of the report but did not affect the quality of the output.

3.0 PARTICIPATION IN TERTIARY EDUCATION

Participation in tertiary education is an indicator that shows a country's performance in terms of comparative effectiveness of its tertiary education system. It refers to student enrolment at tertiary level and includes higher education and Technical and Vocational Education and Training (TVET).

3.1 Student Enrolment

3.1.1 Enrolment Trends

Botswana's Higher Education student enrolment has grown rapidly since 2000. Since then, the country has experienced tremendous growth over the last decade. During then, there has been new universities entrants which expanded the country's higher education system. This diversified the higher education delivery mechanism and allowed entry of private higher education providers. Figure 2 shows the tertiary education enrolment trends from 2004 to 2019.

It shows that overall, there has been an increase in tertiary education enrolments from 20,011 in 2003/04 to the current 53,930 in 2018/19 academic year. Specifically, Higher Education Institutions enrolled a total of 53,930 students during the 2018/19 academic year, thereby making an increase of 0.9% (480) from the previous academic year which had an enrolment of 53, 450 students. Higher Education Institutions recorded the highest enrolment of 60, 583 in 2014/15 and the lowest was 19,655 in 2004/05.

3.1.2 Enrolment Gender Parity Index

Measures of enrolment gender parity in education help to explain how participation and opportunities for schooling compare for females and males. Gender Parity Indices (GPI) show the ratio of female to male for a given indicator. An index of a value less than one indicates that the indicator values are higher for males than for females and vice versa. Accordingly, GPI of 1 means that parity has been achieved. Figure 3 shows the GPI in enrolment for Botswana from 2013 to date.

Trends in Gender Parity Index for the period 2013 to 2019 reveal that the parity has been in favour of females. The analysis presented in figure three clearly indicates that females out number males at the tertiary level of education. Further to that, the index has remained above 1.0 consecutively for seven years. The year 2019 has the highest GPI of 1.5 in tertiary enrolment meaning that a total of hundred and fifty (150) females were enrolled against every one hundred (100) males.

3.1.3 Enrolment by Institution Type



The data presented in Table 2 highlights the distribution of students among the different types of higher education providers. From the table, it is clear that the universities (both private and public) dominate the overall share of enrolments in higher education. Majority of the students (22,742) were enrolled in public universities which is made up of Botswana University of Agriculture and Natural Resources (BUAN), Botswana Open University (BOU), Botswana International University of Science and Technology (BIUST) and University of Botswana. Private universities (Ba Isago, Botho and Limkokwing) were the second largest with total enrolment of 11,009. The lowest enrolment, (1,174) was recorded from the Colleges of Education. Female enrolment was 32,255 and accounted for almost sixty (60) percent of the total enrolment. Table 2 shows a relatively higher share of female enrolment than male enrolment across all the different types of institutions with the exception of technical colleges whose female enrolment was at 42.5 percent.

3.1.4 Enrolment by Qualification Type

3.1.4.1 Level-wise Enrolment

The total student enrolment was classified according to the National Credit and Qualification Framework (NCQF); Doctor of philosophy (PhD), Masters, Post Graduate, Bachelor's Degree, Diploma, Certificate and the professional courses. Figure 4 shows the percentage share of student enrolment in these levels.

The highest number of students were enrolled at under graduate level. Information deduced from figure 4 shows that ninety-three (93) percent of enrolments are from Certificate, Diploma and the Bachelor's Degree level(s). This is followed by four (4) percent enrolment in master's programmes which is a total of 2,266 students. There were only 123 students who were enrolled at PhD level.



3.1.4.2 Level-wise Enrolment and Equality

Figure 5 presents the gender composition of enrolment at different levels of higher education. It was observed that the concentration was on undergraduate programmes. It is evident that in Botswana, female participation in higher education is higher than males in almost all the qualification levels except for the Doctor of philosophy, where the share of women accounts for only 32.5%. Despite access to higher education, figure 5 shows that less women tend to move up the educational ladder compared to men.



3.1.6 Enrolment by ISCED field of Education

3.1.6.1 Enrolment by Field of Education

In order to ensure data comparability, enrolments were classified into the eight standard broad fields of education in accordance with the ISCED 2011 as per figure 6 below;

The Social Sciences, Business and Law stream has the highest concentration of students and accounted for 44 percent of the total student population. Education is the second major stream with 13 percent. Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics (STEM) are a third major stream and account for 24 percent (12 percent each) of the enrolment. STEM programmes include four and three sub streams from science and engineering respectively which include computing, mathematics and statistics, computer engineering and engineering trades. Agriculture and Services streams were the lowest and accounted for 2 percent each of the total student population.

3.1.6.2 Sex distribution by ISCED field of Education




Figure 7: Proportion of female and male enrolment by field of Education -2018/19

The total enrolment by ISCED fields of education is as per figure 7. A relatively higher share of female enrolment than male was evident across all the fields except for STEM streams. Engineering, Manufacturing & Construction had the lowest number of females. Out of the 6,690 students enrolled, 4,883 were males with 1,807 being females. The highest number of females were enrolled in education programmes. Agriculture, humanities and arts streams show a different picture with a balance between both sexes.




Figure 8: Enrolment Trends by broad fields of Education 2009-2019

The Social Sciences, Business and Law has had the highest number of student population throughout the years. Specifically, during the 2017/18 academic year, a total of 19,842 students were enrolled in Social Sciences, Business and Law and the number increased to 23,443 students in academic year 2018/19. This is a broad discipline with four major sub stream being the social and behavioural sciences, journalism and information, business and administration and law. Generally, there has been a decrease in the number of students enrolled in STEM programmes, for example, the Engineering, Manufacturing and Construction had the highest student population of 9,820 during the 2016/17 academic year and the number has since decreased to 6,488 in 2018/19. Agriculture sub stream had the lowest number of students throughout the years from 2009 to 2018. In 2018/19 the services sub stream had the lowest student enrolment of 869.

3.1.7 International Students

3.1.7.1 Enrolment by Country of Origin

The total number of foreign national students enrolled in Botswana's Tertiary Institutions is nine hundred and eighty eight (988). These foreign students come from 41 different countries across the globe. Table 7 presents the number of foreign students from tertiary education institutions by country of origin. According to Table 7, the highest share of students come from neighbouring SADC countries of which Zimbabwe constitutes 34 percent of the total, followed by Zambia at 13.5 percent, Namibia at 11.7 percent and Eswatini at 10.9 percent.

3.1.8 Gross Enrolment Ratio

3.1.8.1 Gross Tertiary Enrolment Ratio


Botswana's Gross Enrolment Ratio (GER) in tertiary education is calculated for the 18-24 population age group and is an indicator that shows the overall coverage of an educational system in relation to the population eligible for participation. The indicator is also used to compare participation between areas in a given country or can be used for comparing two or more countries. Gross Enrolment Ratio was at 18.5 percent in 2019, registering a 0.2 percentage point increase from the previous year. As alluded to section A, a total of 53,930 students were enrolled in the county's universities and colleges and the number is expressed as a percentage of the official tertiary education school - age population. Table 8 present the total student enrolments, projected 18-24 age population cohort as well as the calculated GER for the past sequential twelve years.



Figure 9 indicates fluctuations in Gross Tertiary Enrolment ratios. For example in 2009 GER was at 17.3 percent and Botswana as a country has had an increase of only 1.2 percentage points in the last decade. Generally, the observation is that there has been an increase in GER which translates into an improvement in access to tertiary education as evidenced by the upward trend in the Gross Tertiary Education Enrolment Rate which rose from 11.4% with the total enrolment of 31,129 in 2007/08 to 20.2% with the total enrolment of 59,091 in 2016/17

3.1.8.3 Gross Tertiary Enrolment Ratio-Comparison

Figure 10 below presents Gross Tertiary Enrolment Ratio (GTER) comparisons between Botswana and other countries regionally and internationally from 2007 to 2018. From 2007 to 2016, Botswana's GTER increased gradually from 11.4 to 22.6 percent. It however, dropped in 2017 to 18.2 percent and increased slightly in 2018 to 18.5 percent. Botswana has had slightly higher GTER compared to other countries in the SADC region. Mauritius has been the only SADC country with a GTER of more than 40 percent. Botswana's GTER is significantly lower compared to upper middle income countries that has an average GTER of 53.0 percent.

4.0 TRANSITION

4.1 Transition from Basic to Tertiary Education

Mainstream secondary education in Botswana is divided into two education levels; junior and senior secondary education. Transition from basic education to tertiary focuses on mobility of students from senior secondary to tertiary education. These are students who have successfully completed the Botswana General Certificate of Secondary Education (BGCSE) or any other internationally recognised attainment level. Table 9 presents the total number of students who sat for the BGCSE in the respective years.

4.1.2 Transition Rate

Transition rate is the number of students admitted to the first year of tertiary education in a given year, expressed as a percentage of the total number of students enrolled in the final grade of the senior secondary level of education in the previous year, i.e. the total number of students who sat for the BGCSE in the previous year. The indicator conveys information on the degree of access from low to a higher level of education within a country.


5.0 GRADUATES

5.1 Tertiary Education Graduates

Tertiary education graduates are those who graduated from universities, colleges, trade schools as well as vocational centres with a certificate qualification or advanced research degree at doctorate level. These tertiary graduates are in two folds; those who completed their tertiary education within the reference period as first timers and those graduating within the same period but had graduated from tertiary education at least once in their lifetime.

5.1.1 Trends

Graduate trends of tertiary education from year 2009 to 2018 are shown in figure 11.

As per the findings of the 2018/19 Institutional census, a total number of students graduating from the system was 11 631, a decrease of 1990 graduates from the previous census. The graduation rate¹, which was calculated only for undergraduate level was recorded at 79.8% during the 2018/19 financial year.




Figure 12: Figure 12: Number of Graduates by Qualification Level

Figure 12 shows a percentage share of graduate students in different levels of qualifications. Bachelor's degree had a total of 5 503 graduates constituting 48 percent and was the highest among all the levels. Diploma was the second highest with 4 436 (38 percent) students. A total of 484 (4 percent) students graduated with Masters and only 20 students graduated with Doctor of Philosophy.

6.0 BUDGET

6.1 Number of Tertiary Students on Government sponsorship

6.1.1 Trends




Figure 13: Tertiary Education Students on Government Sponsorship - 2008/9 - 2016/17.

The Government of Botswana has, over the years, been committed to increasing access to tertiary education through awarding of Government sponsorships. The number of tertiary education students sponsored by Government between 2008/09 and 2016/17 is presented in figure 13.

Figure 13 indicates that the number of tertiary education students on Government sponsorship increased from 28,976 in 2009/10 to 48,703 in 2012/13. This constituted a 68.1 percent increase over the five-year period. Thereafter, the number of tertiary education students on Government sponsorship gradually decreased from 48,703 in 2012/13 to 38,806 in 2016/17. Although there was a decline in the number of students on sponsorship from 2012/13 to 2016/17, it should, however, be noted that generally the decline never dropped below the 2008/09 count of 28,876.
