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PREFACE

This is the fourth issue of the Vital Statistics Report produced by the Crime and Vital Statistics unit of Statistics Botswana. The report is intended to provide a quick reference to some basic population indicators as well as the performance of Civil Registration and Vital Statistics (CRVS) in the country. It is organized in three parts, i) Births, ii) Marriages and iii) Deaths.

This publication is a result of collaborative effort between Statistics Botswana and the Department of Civil and National Registration of the Ministry of Labour and Home Affairs.

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1.0 INTRODUCTION

Civil registration ensures or verifies that a person exists and captures in detail the characteristics of that particular person. This is important for informing public policy, planning and service delivery in a country. Therefore, a strong link has to be developed between Civil registration and Vital Statistics in order to have quality and timely statistics that can be used for planning and decision making purposes.

1.1 Birth Registration

Birth registration gives an identity and allows one to have a birth certificate which in turn provides proof of age, biological parentage, identification (omang) and acquisition of a passport. Without a birth certificate one faces exclusion from a number of life time benefits and services. Access to social amenities like health care, education and social assistance cannot be enjoyed without a birth certificate.

1.2 Death Registration

The death registration is important for legal reasons, personal reasons and for the production of vital statistics. It is used as a permanent legal record of the fact of death. Death registration information is used in the application for insurance benefits, settlement of pension claims, transfer of real and personal property among others. It is also used for personal for peace of mind as it facilitates efficient processing of needed benefits such as those described above. Birth and Death registration data is used for statistical purposes to provide information on fertility and mortality. Indicators such as crude birth rate, total fertility rate, mean age at birth, nuptial births, and infant mortality, under five mortality and Crude death rates as well as causes of death can be produced from the births and deaths registration data.

1.3 Source

Administrative data on births, deaths and marriages is obtained from the Department of Civil and National Registration (DCNR) of the Ministry of Labour and Home Affairs (MLHA). The data on births and deaths is obtained electronically from the DCNR while marriage data is extracted manually from the marriage certificates filed with the Department. The data is then processed by the Crime, Civil and Vital Statistics Unit of Statistics Botswana for the production of vital statistics report. On the one hand, information on divorce cases captured by the Administration of Justice does not have all the variables needed to produce a detailed report on divorces.

1.4 Coverage

Births and deaths analyzed in this report occurred and were registered in 2014 and those that occurred in the earlier years but registered in 2014. It includes births, deaths and marriages that occurred to citizens and non-citizens within the borders of the country. It also includes both institutional and non-institutional births and deaths. On the other hand, marriages analyzed in this report are those solemnized in Botswana for each calendar year by either the District Commissioner or church minister appointed by the Minister of Home Affairs as marriage officer.

2.1. Birth Registration

Data collection on birth registration includes all births that occurred and were registered with the Department of Civil and National Registration (CNR). The CNR is mandated with registration of all vital events in the country. The scope of the statistics on birth registration includes both live and still births, births that occurred in earlier years that have not been previously registered (late registration) and all births that occurred within the country borders and births to non-citizens.

Table 2.1 shows that there were a total of 79,540 births registered in 2014. Out of this number around 99 percent were live births and 52.2 percent of the live births were registered timely (within 60 days of occurrence) while the rest were late registrations. Birth registration is steadily increasing over the years rising from 75.9 in 2011 to 83.2 percent in 2014. Late registration constituted 47.8 percent of all registrations occurred in 2014. The high percentage of late registration is an indication that members of the public are responding positively to the campaigns that the department of CNR and development partners are carrying out across the country.

2.2 Trends in Births Registration

There were 79,540 births registered in 2014 which included both live and still births. Chart 1 shows an upward trend in the number of births registered over the years which may be the impact of campaigns by CNR and the requirement of birth registration for registration in schooling and accessing health facilities.




Chart 1: Trends in births registration 2011-2014

2.3 Recorded live births

The total live births registered in 2014 were 78,996 across the country. The total consists of timely registrations and late registrations. Timely registrations are births that were registered within 60 days of occurrence as stipulated in the Births and Deaths Act. The birth might have occurred in the previous year and registered within the given timelines. All births registered outside the 60 days are referred to as late registrations. Chart 2 below shows that 52 percent of the births that were registered in 2014 were timely registrations while the remaining were late registrations.




Chart 2: Total Registered births by status of Registration-2014

2.4 Sex of the child

Chart 3 shows that for all the births that occurred and were registered in 2014, about 51 percent of them were male babies, resulting in a sex ratio at birth of 103 male births per 100 females.

2.5 Registered live births by district

Chart 4 shows the distribution of registered births that occurred in 2014 by the district of birth and the district of usual residence of the mother at the time of birth. The highest number of around 18 percent of births that occurred and were registered in 2014 occurred in Gaborone and the least number of births occurred in Ngamiland Delta and Sowa Town. This could be attributed to the fact that Gaborone district has the highest population and best health facilities and more registration centres as compared to other districts. It should also be noted that for all cities and towns, the number of births registered given by the birth district is more than births registered given by district of residence. This suggests that people move from their usual place of residence to give birth in towns and cities where there are better health facilities.




Chart 4: Registered live births by districts of birth and residence-2014

Chart 5 gives a distribution of registered births that occurred in 2014 by registration centres. Princess Marina Hospital registration centre registered the highest number of births 5,575 accounting for 13.2 percent of all the registered births for the year 2014, followed by Nyangabaywe with 4,427 (10.5 percent)

births registered. The lowest number of births was registered at Orapa with only 5 births registered in 2014.




Chart 5: Registered live births by registration centres -2014

2.6 Age of mother

Table 2.2 shows the distribution of registered live births that occurred and were registered in 2014 by age of the mother and the result of delivery. The highest percentage of live births occurred among women in the age groups 20-24 followed by age group 25-29 and 30-34 accounting for 70.8 percent of all births registered in 2014. The mean age at birth increased slightly to 27.6 after remaining constant at 27.3 since 2011 (summary table). About 99 percent of the mothers who gave birth in this year fall within the reproductive ages of 15-49. Women aged below age 15 accounted for about 0.1 percent of women who gave birth in 2014 and those aged above 50 years accounted for 0.03 percent of births. Teenage births accounted for about 9 percent of births that occurred in 2014 of which 0.07 percent were aged below 15 years.

2.7 Month of occurrence and registration

It is evident as depicted by Chart 6 that for all the months of the year more than 80 percent of births occurring were registered in the same month.

Table 2.3 below shows the period of registration by level of education according to the definition of current and late registration as stipulated in the Births and Death Act. As per the Act, a live or still-birth shall be registered before expiry of 60 days from date of occurrence; otherwise it is regarded as a late registration. This table shows that within the category of people who do not possess any educational qualification, only 8.6 percent of their children's births were registered timeously. These are followed by those with Primary as their highest level of education (34.1 Percent). There is a prevailing pattern in the table indicating that timely registrations increase with increased levels of education. About 52 percent of all births registered in 2014, were registered within the stipulated period of 60 days from date of birth. This however does not show slackness in birth registration but shows that more children who were previously not registered are being registered.

2.8 Place of birth

Of all the live births that occurred and were registered in 2014, only 204 (0.5 percent) occurred at home and the rest 41,537 (99.5 percent) occurred in health facilities. This shows that access to maternity health facilities is high in the country.

2.9 Marital status of the mother

Chart 7 below shows that 76.1 percent of births that occurred and were registered in 2014 were born to single mothers, accounting for the largest percentage of all the births, followed by the married with 23.5 percent. The divorced and widowed accounted for 0.3 percent of all births in 2014.

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3.0 Marriages

Marriage is an event which is regulated by statute and about which information is collected for legal and statistical purposes. The Department of Civil and National Registration (CNR) is responsible for data collection through the registration service of vital events.

This section includes time series table of marriages that occurred from 2005 to 2014. It also includes tables on age at marriage, previous marital status, profession of both the groom and bride and the district of marriage.

3.1 Trends in Marriages (2005-2014)

Chart 8 shows that the number of marriages registered were on an increase for the years prior to 2008. The trend shows a downward curve during the period 2009 to 2011 which incidentally was the period when the world was experiencing an economic downturn. Marriages increased drastically from 4,601 in 2011 to 5,214 in 2012 and continued to steadily increase to 5,591 in 2014.




Chart 8: Total number of marriages registered-2005-2014

3.2 District of Registration

Chart 9 shows that the highest proportion of marriages were registered in Gaborone, which accounted for about 12 percent of all marriages. It was closely followed by Kweneng East, and then Ngwaketse South. Ngamiland West registered the least number of marriages constituting 0.1 percent of all marriages.




Chart 9: Percentage distribution of registered marriages by registration district-2014

3.3 Month of Registration

Chart 10 shows percentage of marriages registered in 2014 by month of registration. The chart shows low levels of marriages in the first half of the year ie January to June. From July the number of marriages increased steadily until December. About 18 percent of all marriages were registered in December. The lowest percentage of marriages was registered in January (2.1 Percent)




Chart 10: Registered marriages by month of registration-2014

3.4 Type of Marriage

There are two types of marriages, those announced through Court Banns (the usual practice of proclaiming the names of the candidates for a period of 21 days before formalizing the marriage) and those done through a Special License that expedites the marriage process. As depicted by Chart 11, the court banns were the most popular type of marriage, constituting about 98 percent of all the marriages registered in 2014 while the Special License marriages constituted the remaining 2 percent.

3.5 Age at the Time of Marriage

Table 3.1 below shows that the mean age at first marriage for bachelors was 39 years in 2014, while the comparable figure for spinsters was 34 years. The mean age at first marriage has been increasing gradually, but with fluctuations over the past 10 years for both males and females. Since 2005, the mean age at marriage has increased by 1.7 years for males and 2.3 years for females.

3.6 Registered Marriages and Occupation

The proportions of males and females marrying differ across different occupations as depicted by Table 3.3. In 2014, the highest proportion (15.8 percent) of males marrying fell within the category of legislators, administrators and managers. Marriage for females was highest (34.6 percent) for those who were not employed

3.7 Previous Marital Status

In 2014 about 93.5 percent of people getting married had not been married previously i.e both male and female. Males who were getting married for the first time (bachelors) constituted 90.6 percent of all the marriages and spinsters accounted for 96.3 percent of all the marriages. About 7 percent of men getting married were previously divorced and 2.2 percent were widowed. Only 3 percent and 1 percent of females getting married were divorced and widowed respectively. (Chart 12).

3.8 First Marriages and Re-marriages

Chart 13 shows that, marriages between spinsters and bachelors account for 88.5 percent of all the marriages registered in 2014, while 10 percent were first marriages for one partner. Remarriages accounted for the remaining 1.5 percent.




Chart 13: First marriages and re-marriages-2014

3.9 Crude Marriage Rate

The crude marriage rate gives the number of persons marrying within a specified time period per 1,000 population of all ages. Table 3.4 shows that the crude marriage rate for Botswana is steadily increasing from 4.54 in 2011 to 5.45 marriages per 1,000 population in 2014. The crude marriage rate was highest in 2007 and 2008 with around 6 per 1,000 population.

4.1 Death Registration

The Death Registrations includes all deaths that occurred and were registered in the country during the reference year and deaths that occurred in earlier years that have not previously been registered. It also includes deaths of persons whose place of usual residence was outside the country provided the death occurred within borders. A total of 13,564 deaths were registered in 2014.

This section provides the distribution of all deaths that were registered in 2014 by age, sex, marital status, educational level, place or institution of death occurrence, district of usual residence of the deceased and center of registration.

4.2 Timely and Late Death Registration

According to the Births and Deaths Act of Civil and National registration (CNR), deaths are considered to be late if they are registered after expiry of thirty days from the date of occurrence. Chart 14 below shows that of all the deaths registered in 2014 only 11 percent were late registration.

4.3 Trends in death registration 2012-2014

There was a decrease in the number of deaths that occurred and were registered in 2014 (12,177) as compared to those that occurred and were registered in 2012 (12,270), showing a 0.76 percent decrease. On the other hand there is an upward trend in late registration from 2012 to 2014 indicating that deaths that were not previously registered are being registered (chart 15).




Chart 15: Trends in death registration 2012-2014

4.4 Registered deaths by age and sex

There were 6,282 male deaths compared to 5,895 female deaths that occurred and were registered in 2014 resulting in a sex ratio of 106.6 male deaths for every 100 female deaths. Chart 16 below shows a high percentage of infant deaths with males slightly higher than females. The proportion of deaths registered decreased sharply from age <1 to 1-4 for both sexes, remained low at age groups 1-4 to 10-14 then gradually increased with females on the higher side until the age-group 35-39. From ages 40 -79 there were more male than female deaths.




Chart 16: Percent distribution of deaths that occurred and were registered in 2014 by age and sex - 2014

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Chart 17 shows the distribution of deaths by age group and sex. This is to establish the proportion of male and female deaths within age groups. From infancy (<1) to 15-19 there were more male than female deaths. For the age groups 19-24 to 35-39 there were more female than male deaths, and the chart follows that pattern to the end.




Chart 17: Percent distribution of deaths within age groups that occurred and were registered in 2014 by sex - 2014

4.5 Age Specific Death Rates 2014

The chart below shows an Infant Mortality Rate of 20.8 deaths per a thousand live births and the death rate falls to 1.2 at age group 1-4 and remains at low levels till age group 20-24 when it starts to increase steadily to older ages.




Chart 18: Age Specific Death Rates 2014

4.6 Sex of the deceased

Chart 19 shows that there were more male deaths (52 percent) registered as compared to female deaths (48 percent).




Chart 19: Deaths registered and occurred in 2014 by sex of deceased-2014

4.7 Month of Occurrence

Chart 20 below shows the percentage of deaths that were registered in 2014 by month of occurrence. The month of August recorded the highest proportion of deaths registered (9.1 percent). There was a gradual decrease over the subsequent months to 7.6 percent in November.

4.8 Centre of Registration

Chart 21 shows that the highest proportions of deaths were registered at the country's two (2) referral hospitals. Princess Marina Hospital registered 15.9 percent of the deaths, while Nyangabgwe registered 10.9 percent. This may be attributed to the fact that difficult cases which are likely to result in death are referred to these two hospitals from the entire country.




Chart 21: Percentage distribution of deaths by district of registration-2014

4.9 Crude Death Rates

A Crude Death Rate (CDR) of 5.6 deaths per a thousand population was recorded which is comparable with the 2011 Population Census figure of 6.25 deaths per a thousand population. The Southern district recorded the highest Crude Death Rate (CDR) of 7.8 deaths per a thousand population followed closely by Central Mahalapye (7.3), Central Tutume (7.2) and Serowe Palapye (7.0). Sowa Town registered the lowest CDR of 0.3 deaths per a thousand population (chart 22). It is worth noting that cities and towns have low CDR despite high registration of deaths.




Chart 22: Crude Death Rates by District of usual living-2014

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4.10 Place of death occurrence, Marital status and Educational level

Table 4.1 shows that 53.4 percent of all registered deaths occurred in health facilities. About 57 percent of the deceased were reported to have been single at the time of death (children included). The highest percent of the deceased had reportedly attained primary education at 41.1 percent followed by those who had no education at 38 percent.
